

Question and Answer for RFSO 01R11-22-S025

Q1. One of the requirements (Attachment 1, appendix D, Mandatory Criteria, section 2) is that the "Journey man" refrigeration technician also hold a "Class M" electrical license.

In Alberta a class "M" would refer to a "Master" Electrician, there is no higher class of Electrician in Alberta. This requirement would mean that only dual ticketed, fully qualified Refrigeration and fully qualified "Master " electricians would meet this requirement. In some other provinces a "Class M ticket" is kind of like a limited trade ticket that can be included with other trades like Refrigeration as an addition. This does not exist in Alberta that I am aware of.

Could you please clarify if a dual ticketed Refrigeration and Master Electrician is required. Or can it be two separate people.

A1. They can be two people. A master is too high for Refrigeration Services at the Research and Development Center in Lacombe AB . Class H would be acceptable for a journeyman as well.
