1. Address questions from Industry:

	Question	Answer
1.	CADD/Drafts people typically work on design documents, while GIS specialists generate the kind of spatial analysis maps used in environmental impact assessments. GIS and CADD work can have widely variable costs/charge rates. Does PWGSC anticipate requiring GIS? If so, should it be a separate rate category?	A separate rate category is not required for GIS work at this time.
2.	Within SRE 2 (subsection 2.4 item 2) it states that "Minimum font size - 11 point Times or equal" should be used. Does this font size apply to graphics?	11 point font size should be used for all text within the document. If graphics are included that have text embedded within them that can not be edited the text should be large enough to be legible.
3.	Can PSPC confirm that a combined project description that clearly describes one project that satisfies multiple project categories, and is clearly stated as such, will be scored the same as if the descriptions were broken out as separate project descriptions for each of the respective categories (e.g., one project description that covers Categories 1.1 through 1.3)?	Correct - a combined project description will be scored the same as if the description was broken out as separate project descriptions. However, it should be clear which project categories the project description is addressing.
