Questions & Answers # 2

- Q4.** We note that the mandatory criteria are quite stringent with requirements for numbers of projects (2 for microgrid), size (Can 100,000+), similar context, developing country location and having been completed rather than underway. Would you consider either making the individual mandatory criteria significantly less stringent or requiring 2 or more of the criteria to be met for each project presented rather than all of them?
- A4.** No. Considering the complexity of the project, we have determined that the all the criteria are necessary to ensure the winning Bidder has the required expertise to successfully complete the project. Bidders are able to submit a joint venture or partnership proposal to meet the mandatory technical criteria.
- Q5.** Would DFATD consider removing the reference project requirement of similar work having been done “in a Developing Country”?
- A5.** No. Considering the complexity of the project, we would recommend the Bidders to have a joint venture or partnership with candidates or companies in a Developing country to meet the mandatory technical criteria.
- Q6.** Our contact, will be in Abuja this weekend for another project – could they be granted access to visit the High Commission property and/or meet with a Departmental Representative?
- A6.** No site visit is planned for this solicitation.
