#### **4.3 Technical Evaluation**

##### **4.3.1 Mandatory Technical Criteria**

Proposals must comply with each and every mandatory requirement of this section. Failure to do so will render the proposal non-compliant. If a proposal is determined to be non-compliant, it will be given no further consideration. Deviations from or issues concerning mandatory requirements are not to be raised in the Bidder's proposal as they will not be considered or accepted after the closing date and time of this RFP.

- (1) The Bidder must provide with their bid, documentation to prove that the legal entity which is submitting the bid has a minimum of two years of waste management services contract experience similar to the requirements stated in Annex "A", that is valued at a minimum of \$600,000.00 per year within the past five years (from the bid closing date) under a maximum of two separate contracts. For this mandatory requirement the Bidder must provide as a minimum, the following information as per the attached Annex H
  - a) The Customer's name and address for each similar contract.
  - b) The name, title, telephone number and e-mail address (unless the individual does not have an e-mail address) for a customer reference that can confirm the information provided by the

Bidder. If the named individual is unavailable when required during the evaluation period the Bidder may provide the name and contact information of an alternative contact from the same customer. This additional contact information must be provided to Canada with your Bid. Canada will attempt to contact each reference provided by the Bidder a maximum of three (3) times. If there is no reply after three (3) attempts, Canada will not evaluate the contract information which was provided by the Bidder.

- c) The start and end dates of each similar contract.
- d) The description of the service that was provided by the Bidder for each contract. The description(s) must prove that the service was similar to the service required in this RFP.
- e) The value of the Contract.

The contract must have been performed by the Bidder itself (and does not include the experience of any proposed subcontractor or any affiliate of the Bidder). However, several entities may combine their experience by submitting a bid as a joint venture; in that case, the bid can describe the previous experience of one or more joint venture members, to meet the experience requirement — that is, one similar contract could be described for one joint venture member and another contract could be described for another joint venture member. If two members of the joint venture worked on the same work site at the same time, it will only be counted as one contract.

- (2) The Bidder must provide with their bid a copy of their Environmental Activity and Registration permit from the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks.
