A. ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED (Q1)

Question 1: Terms of Reference, Section 2.2. The responsibilities of the geotechnical consultant are stated to include: providing guidance on safe operation of the dam system in accordance with best practices, and performing detailed inspections of dams on behalf of Canada. In the context of tailings dams and tailings storage facilities (TSF) in the mining industry, these responsibilities are owned exclusively by the engineer fulfilling the role of Engineer of Record (EOR). The RFP is silent on whether the Geotechnical Consultant is expected to fulfill the role of EOR for the project. However, in the Terms of Reference for the RFP for the Remediation Pan Design and Support Services contract (RPD/SS; EZ897-212881) it is stated that the RPD/SS Consultant is responsible for being the EOR for all works designed under this contract. It is also understood that the Main Construction Manager is responsible for the care and maintenance of the site including operation of the TSF. Can PSPC please clearly identify which of the parties will serve as the EOR and be responsible for the safe operation of the TSF?

Answer 1: In the future, the intent is for the Geotechnical Consultant to become the Interim Engineer of Record, as defined and discussed in Appendix 5 [The NCSP Dam Safety Management System]. Canada will also work with the Geotechnical Consultant towards the goal of eventually becoming the EOR. Canada will remain the EOR until an agreement can be reached.

From the NSCP Dam Safety Management System: 'While the candidate EOR is engaged to gain an understanding of the dam and conducting the Dam safety and stability review, they should be referred to as the Interim EOR. An Interim EOR will not need to sign a formal EOR agreement nor have the responsibilities of the EOR. The intent of the Interim EOR title is to allow candidate EORs to satisfy themselves that they are willing to accept the responsibilities of EOR for the dam'.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
