Questions and Answers #2 - Event Management services - EC Bid Solicitation No. 5000066137

Q1) National pavilions at COPs are always extensively decorated with large scale photographs, logos, banners and other visual materials. I would expect that CANADA plans to do the same thing in the Canadian pavilion. There is no reference in the RFP to the material or design costs of setting up and decorating the pavilion - only to the costs of designing and delivering events on site. Do these costs fall outside the scope of work for this RFP and will they be addressed by ECCC in some other way?

A1) Yes. The build, design and furnishing of the pavilion will be procured through a sole-source entity to be identified by the Egyptian COP27 Presidency. These costs fall outside the scope of work.

Q2) Also, there is no reference in the RFP to the costs of providing simultaneous interpretation in both English and French for all events in the Canada pavilion. Will these costs by covered by ECCC outside of this contract?

A2) Yes. These costs fall outside the scope of work given the level of information available at this point from the Egyptian COP27 Presidency.
