Solicitation Amendment 011 is raised to respond to questions from the Industry.

- Q1. What is the current reporting line for Technical Labour / Engineers? (Please provide additional detail to enable Canada to prepare an accurate response to this question.)
- Supplemental Clarification: Does the technical Labour/Engineers resident or temporary provide by the contractor reported directly to the DFATD Mission Property Team.
- R1. The technical labour / engineers engaged by the incumbent Contractor to deliver the services included in the expiring Contract for the Canadian High Commission in London, UK, do not report directly to the Mission Property Team.
- Q2. What is the current Temporary Staff / Agency Staff Supply Chain delivery model?
- Request for clarification by GAC: Are you requesting information on the temporary / agency staff used by the current Contractor, or the composition of the DFATD Mission Property Team?
- Supplemental Clarification: Does the current contractor provide resident building technician or other staff from their internal personal. For instance: resident electrical technician, HVAC technician, Plumbing Technician etc.. If yes, how many?
- Does DFATD Mission property team has building technician in his team?
- R2. There are no Building Technicians directly employed by DFATD's Mission Property Team. In accordance with Section 2.4, Enquiries – Bid Solicitation of Part 2 – Bidder Instructions of the Request for Proposal (RFP), Canada will not provide responses to questions deemed to be proprietary in nature. This question is soliciting information on the composition of the incumbent Contractor's service delivery team. As this information is deemed to be proprietary to the incumbent Contractor, Canada will not provide a response.
- Q3. Request for Clarification by GAC: Are the requested details on the supply chain delivery model specific to the current Contractor, or the DFATD Mission Property Team? Please provide additional clarification to enable Canada to prepare an accurate response to the question.)
- Supplemental clarification: What services are self-perform by the current contractor? What services are subcontracted?
- R3. In accordance with Section 2.4, Enquiries – Bid Solicitation of Part 2 – Bidder Instructions of the Request for Proposal (RFP), Canada will not provide responses to questions deemed to be proprietary in nature. This question is soliciting information on the service delivery model employed by the incumbent Contractor (e.g.: self-delivery versus the use of subcontracted resources). As this information is deemed to be proprietary to the incumbent Contractor, Canada will not provide a response.
- Q4. May the Contractor subcontract work to its affiliated entity outside of Canada without the need for the Contractor to conduct a competitive subcontracting process described in Section 2.5 of the Statement of Work?

- R4. If the Bidder's intent is to use a legal subsidiary of the Bidder's parent organization to deliver services that form part of the Statement of Work, the subcontracting requirements included in Section 2.5 - Subcontractor Management of the Statement of Work would not apply. However, the subsidiary would be obligated to comply with the requirements included in Section 2.5 – Subcontractor Management if / when work is subcontracted to third parties
- Q5. If a Bidder intends to subcontract some work to its affiliate outside of Canada, please advise whether that affiliate is to be considered a Foreign recipient Subcontractor requiring permission of the Canadian DSA and, if so, advise whether the deadline for that Foreign recipient Subcontractor to obtain the permission of the Canadian DSA is (a) prior to bid submission, (b) contract award, (c) subcontract award, (d) performance of services, or (e) any other date.
- R5. Please refer to Section 7.3 Security Requirements of the RFP.
- Security conditions are required before contract award and during the period of the contract.

- Q6. If a Bidder is a joint venture, is a DOS security clearance required by only one member of the joint venture, by each member of the joint venture, or by the joint venture?"
- R6. All security requirements in the Contract apply to each member of the joint venture Contractor. Refer to Section 7.5.4 Joint Venture Contractor (only if required) of the RFP.
- Q7. Appendix K: Confidentiality Agreement is request to be included as part of Section IV of bidders submission. Section 2.10 Confidential Information for Bidding , mentions additional information will be sent upon submission of Appendix K, in support of the preparation of a bid in response. Can Canada please confirm that the NDA only needs to be submitted with the bidders response and there is no additional confidential information at this time?
- R7. Yes, the signed Confidentiality Agreement is required with the bid (Section IV: Additional Information)
- Q8. Within Project Delivery categories I and II baseline spend can Canada confirm approximate # of projects and project types?
- R8. No. The type, number and value of the category I and II projects to be delivered at the Canadian High Commission in London, UK, will vary from year to year. As a result, Canada cannot confirm the number or type of projects that Bidder's will be required to deliver, beyond the information provided in Section 4.0 – Project Delivery Services of the Statement of Work. Canada has provided Bidders with access to Building Condition Reports (BCR's) prepared for 5 Trafalgar Square and 2-4 Cockspur Street on the Central Collab site maintained by DFATD. The BCR's provide Bidders with information on the nature and extent of repair and/or recapitalization work that may be required at the specified locations in the coming years.
