THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENT TO THE TENDER DOCUMENTS IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
THE AMENDMENT SHALL FORM A PART OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.
All other terms and conditions remain the same.

This solicitation is hereby amended to provide the following questions and answers:

Question #1: Who cleans the supply and return diffusers in the ceiling? What time frame can this work be completed? When were they last completed?

Answer #1: The cleaning contractor is required to clean the diffusers. This work is to be schedule with PSPC and will be required no more than four times a year with the first cleaning done within the 1st month of the beginning of the awarded contract. The last cleaning was approximately six months ago due to buildings low occupancy rate.

Question #2: Who cleans the ceiling lights? How long will it take to complete the work?

Answer #2: Every five years a contracted electrician inspects and cleans the lighting fixtures, which 2022 happens to be one of those years. The cleaning contractor is required to dust the light fixtures twice a year, but in this year the electrical contractor's work will count as one of those cleanings. The length of time it will take to perform this cleaning will depend on the number of staff assigned to the job, but past contractors have been able to accomplish this task in 3-4 days.

Question #3: What is used for cleaning the escalators?

Answer #3: The contractor is to use eco-friendly "green" products. Multiple products may be required as the products used must be designed to clean the different surfaces, which are glass, stainless steel and aluminum. All cleaning products used on site must be cleared with a PSPC representative and a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) must be provided to a PSPC rep prior to taking the product on site.

Question #4: Does the current contract use an auto scrubber for the floors?

Answer #4: The current contractor does use an auto scrubber, but this type of machine is only allowed to be used on the floors with epoxy surfaces.

Question #5: Who cleans the high glass on the 2nd floor, where you see the sign EAST and WEST ?

Answer #5: The cleaning contractor is required to clean those glass walls, along with all other glass partitions/walls 3 times a year.
