**Reference: 2003 Standard Instructions – Goods or Services – Competitive Requirements**

Q7 What would a resulting contract look like for a successful consortium (joint venture) bid? Would PWGSC issue a multi-party Task Authorization contract and would the payments be made from PWGSC directly to the entity that is leading the task?

A7 I would like to direct you to 2003, Standard Instructions – Goods or Services – Competitive Requirements, article 10 (2007-05-25), Legal Capacity. It is imperative that any bidder have the legal capacity to act on behalf of the joint venture.

I would also like to direct you to article 17 (2010-01-11) Joint Venture, which provides information on submitting a bid as a joint venture. As detailed therein, the contract is awarded to one entity, comprised of multiple parties, all of whom must sign the bid. The name of that entity is entirely at your discretion. It may be a new business entity with a Canada Revenue Agency business number (and procurement business number), or may be directed to the party who will act as the legal authority and representatives for the joint venture. It is important to ensure the information requested in 2003 Standard Instructions article 2040 17 is provided.

Q8 Each member organization of a joint venture will have different hourly rates, should we assign estimated percentage of work from each organizations for each labour category and adjust the estimated effort base on that estimated percentage when completing Attachment 1 to Part 3?

A8 A joint venture is submitting a bid as a single entity. How the firm, all inclusive hourly rates are determined is completely at the bidder's discretion; however, only a single rate will be accepted for each resource category. How that rate is determined is up to you.
