Responses to the questions below may be provided by email to Sandra.lomax@pwgsc-tpsgc.gc.ca. We are requesting the responses/feedback by June 23, 2022.

The Government of Canada is interested in tracking the impact of its services and programs on its clients' wellness. Veterans Affairs Canada (VAC) is currently considering enhancing our Cannabis for Medical Purposes (CMP) program to focus on wellness. This is a VAC only program, CAF and RCMP do not participate in the CMP program through the Federal Health Claims Processing Services (FHCCPS) contract.

The CMP program (VAC only) is currently included in the FHCCPS contract. Our current approach was outlined at the Virtual Industry Engagement Session, November 2, 2021. VAC is presently examining options to enhance our approach to this program and are seeking the input of industry.

This enhanced approach would propose an evolution to the CMP program from a model which has a focus on claims administration, to a model which would have an enhanced focus on health and wellness. This model is proposed to include, but will not be limited to, counselling Veterans on CMP products (much like a pharmacy for prescription drugs); monitoring of health outcomes identified by the authorizing health care practitioner and Veteran progress made at regular follow-up with the health care practitioner; and, a risk based monitoring frame work.

Seeking Input from Industry:

1. Should the proposed enhancements to the CMP program be included in the FHCCPS procurement, or would Canada and/or the client be better served with these services being provided through a separate contract or other delivery solutions? Please provide the rationale for your response.
2. If the enhanced CMP program was to remain within the FHCCPS contract are there any requirements that would prevent your organization from submitting a proposal? If so, please elaborate.
3. Are there resources available through your organization, such as experts in the field of CMP, who could:
 - provide participants with guidance on choosing CMP products suited to their need;
 - monitor participant progress on health outcomes from follow-up reports by their health care practitioner; and,
 - determine participants at risk, or in need of additional support?Please elaborate as possible with your response.
4. Does your organization feel there are any aspects of the proposed enhanced CMP program that could be served by the FHCCPS contract and other aspects by a separate contract (e.g., claims reimbursement vs counselling, monitoring and analysis)? If so, how would your organization propose the services be contracted to provide the best service to Veterans?
5. What additional information regarding the proposed enhanced approach to CMP would your organization find useful to understand the requirements?
