A. BID CLOSING DATE

The closing date for tender 5P468-22-0038/A is extended from June 21, 2022 to June 28, 2022 at 2:00PM MDT.

- 1. There will be an optional site visit on Wednesday June 22, 2022 at 11am MDT. Interested bidders are to meet at Ottertail Pit approximately 8 Kms West from Field, BC, coordinates 51.348379, -116.548089.
- Interested Bidders will need to drive themselves to each of the sites following Ottertail Pit: Quartz Pit approximately 49 Kms West from Golden, coordinates 51.488992, -117.367347
 Settlers Pit approximately 24 Kms East from Radium Hot Springs, BC coordinates 50.680958, -115.864808
- 3. <u>Safety Attire</u> It is mandatory that all persons attending the site visit have the proper personal protection equipment (safety glasses, footwear, vests and hard hats etc.). Contractor's personnel/individuals who do not have the proper safety attire may be denied access to the site.
- 4. Bidders are requested to communicate with the Contracting Authority before the optional site visit to confirm attendance and provide the name(s) of the person(s) who will attend. Bidders may be requested to sign an attendance sheet. Bidders who do not attend or do not send a representative will not be given an alternative appointment but they will not be precluded from submitting a bid. Any clarifications or changes to the bid solicitation resulting from the site visit will be included as an amendment to the bid solicitation.
- 5. This site visit is subject to the COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Supplier Personnel. The person(s) who attend must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 with a Health Canada-approved COVID-19 vaccine(s), or, for personnel that are unable to be vaccinated due to a certified medical contraindication, religion or other prohibited grounds of discrimination under the Canadian Human Rights Act, subject to accommodation and mitigation measures that have been presented to and approved by Canada.

Q1 Just wondering if there was a Geo, Tech Report or sieve analysis report we need to follow. **A1** PCA does not have a Geo-Tech Report or sieve analysis report.

Q2 The 3 % salt does parks canada supply the Salt.

A2 As per 31 05 16 section 2.1 item 4 Salt for winter abrasives will be supplied by the Owner and is to be mixed at a rate of 4%.

Q3 I need to know from the Sieve analysis report if it requires any Fracture ' This will determine if I need to do Crushing or just a triple deck screener ".

A3 In order to meet our specifications you will be required to do crushing in accordance with 31 05 16 section 3.1 Crushing Plant

Q4 The salt mixture is the 3% mixed will it be added while we are screening or Crushing. Or do we use a second modified application?

A4 Salt for winter abrasives will be supplied by the Owner and is to be mixed at a rate of 4% while screening and crushing.

Q5 I also wanted to GPS the sites to see the millage difference between all the pits. **A5** See section 01 11 00 1.3 Project Location for coordinates and locations of the pits.

Q6 Is there a stock pile of MF crushing materials we screen out of? **A6** No the requirement will be to use raw material pit run

Q7 The 3 gravel pits in the tender was there winter sand contracts processed from these pits previously? **A7** Yes

Q8 For bidding purposes, who would I speak to about a possible variance in the hours of work allowed on the sites. The contract documents allow 7am to 7 pm currently, however variances seem to be negotiable.

A8 For the purpose of the bidding, hours are 7am-7pm any possible variances can be discussed after award.
