Question 2: Does that require that the RFP submission be sent before (assuming 7 days), the delivery date of the equipment?

Response 2: The response to the RFP must be received by Canada on or before the closing date on the first page of the RFP or the latest amendment.

Question 3: When exactly are the services required? Tender says by 30 June.

Response 3: Services are required in Fort Knox, KY starting 5 July 2022 and ending 15 July 2022.

ANNEX "A" STATEMENT OF WORK

INTELLIGENCE, SURVEILLANCE AND RECONNAISSANCE (ISR) SIMULATION SERVICES

1.0 Scope

This Statement of Work (SOW) is to outline the requirements of Department of National Defence (DND) for simulated ISR services.

1.1 Purpose

DND has a requirement for a Contractor to provide simulated ISR services in support of a DND training exercise.

1.2 Background

Traditional ISR services (static imagery) has proven to be expensive, resource intensive and inefficient when fuel, weather, out of service times and the need to hire hundreds of role players, are taken into consideration. Such static imagery also requires a high degree of interpretation and is often found to include inadequate and unrealistic information from what ground forces (GF) encounter on the objective.

DND has a mandate to explore a more cost effective and efficient option, by exploring the production of simulated ISR that displays a digital model of the real objective and the surrounding areas within an acceptable scale with a Master Events List (MEL) superimposed onto the terrain model. Where technicians would superimpose a realistic but simulated ISR type readout that offers information similar to a real ISR feed. This simulated ISR feed could then be controlled by exercise cadre who act as ISR operators interactive with GF members who can actually direct the simulated ISR feed via "chat". This should greatly enhance the situation awareness, leading better planning and more realistic training. There are also further substantial savings as the simulated ISR can be used repetitively on future exercises if the locations remain the same, simply requiring the technicians to deploy without terrain modeling costs.

2.0 Requirements

2.1 The Contractor must provide a total of twenty eight (28) hours of ISR simulation services (twenty (20) hours of daytime and eight (8) hours of night time), utilizing the Anaconda, Chicken Run, HSTL MOUT and Anaconda, Afghan, Redwing and Zussman village Military Operation Urban Terrain (MOUT) sites, to support a DND training exercise in Fort Knox, KY.

- a) DND will require simulated ISR feeds with controllers that would provide the simulated ISR tasking over the areas of Anaconda, Afghan, Chicken Run and HTSL MOUT sites based on scheduled timings. The vendor must not only replicate the training areas, but also be able to superimpose patterns of life (both day and night) based on a provided MEL, which the GF could direct via "chat". The technicians would be able to move and adjust the course of this simulated ISR feed as requested by the GF. The requirement is based on one (1) target location as well as 10 km radius around the target area to include the reproduction of any roads or trails within the 10 km radius of the target as well any other build up areas.
- b) The support must be provided as specified in the technical requirements and fully operational from (all times local) 0900hrs on the 05th of July 2022 until 0800 hours on the 15th of July 2022, which is the planning cycle for all targets in this exercise. Deployment, Redeployment

dates, set up and tear down of equipment must be outside of the 05-15 July 2022 planning times.

- 2.2 The Department of National Defence at CANSOF is requesting simulated ISR lines of operation, both day and night with minimum of two (2) technicians that can direct the ISR based on the GF's direction via "chat". These ISR dedicated lines of task will support planning and mission preparations in Fort Knox, Kentucky focused on the Chicken Run, HSTL MOUT, Anaconda, Afghan, Redwing and Zussman village MOUT sites. See below for detailed breakdown of the specific requirements.

3.0 Deliverables

- 3.1 The Contractor must deliver simulated ISR services, encompassing the requirements listed in Section 2 (Requirements).

- 3.2 The Contractor must not only replicate the training areas, but also be able to superimpose patterns of life (both day and night) based on provided MEL and as directed by GF via "chat".

- 3.3 The Contractor's Instructors must have a minimum of two (2) years' experience providing simulated ISR services (preferably with military organizations).

- 3.4 The Contractor's simulated services must include and not be limited to the following technical specifications:

- a. Based on imagery packages, produce level 2, 3D Base-Line Modelling of 4 (four) sites (Chicken Run, HSTL MOUT, Anaconda, Afghan, Redwing and Zussman village MOUT sites within Fort Knox, KY) and a surrounding area of approximately 10km to include roads, trails and tracks as well as any buildings and built up sites;
- b. Once 3D Base-Line Modelling is completed for Chicken Run, HSTL MOUT, Anaconda, Afghan, Redwing and Zussman village MOUT sites and area, then the model must be inputted into the newly created terrain;
- c. The MEL superimposed onto the Terrain Model produced must show a fulsome population of men, women and children as well as goats, chickens, dogs and horses. The MEL must also show vehicles, weapons and machinery. All items in the MEL must appear to be indigenous to an area similar to Kandahar (Afghanistan) or Mosul (Iraq);
- d. Deliver the full motion video downlink to the planning team during training exercise. The simulated ISR video downlink must show information data in the margins of the screen similar to a MQ-1 or MQ-9 type unmanned ISR platform;
- e. Provide simulated On Station (ONSTA) ISR platforms both day and night that includes a superimposed MEL showing pattern of life that includes people, weapons, vehicles that can replicate the specific region and demographics that are applicable to the location of the given scenario. There must also have the ability to move and adjust the course of the simulated [SR feed as requested by the GF's direction via "chat"; and
- f. Night time simulated ISR tasking must simulate a "thermal" signature.

- 3.5 The Contractor must provide all licenses, software and all hardware needed for both the technicians and DND's GFs within the planning area.

- 3.6 The schedule and timings for the Contractor's sixteen (28) hours of services, will be coordinated between Contractor and DND after Contract execution.
