AMENDMENT 018

This amendment is raised to introduce new clauses to the Task Based Informatics Professional Services (TBIPS) Request for Supply Arrangement (RFSA) solicitation document.

1. Insert to Part 4 – Evaluation Procedures and Basis of Selection

4. Corporate Predecessor Experience

Corporate Predecessor Definition: An existing supplier that is currently qualified under this professional services method of supply and has undergone corporate restructuring which resulted in the divestiture of a portion of the existing supplier in order to create a separate and new entity, at arm's length (i.e., not an affiliate or subsidiary) of the existing supplier or has otherwise transferred the 'Required Corporate Assets' to an arm's length existing entity (in either case, the "new entity").

1. If an existing supplier (hereby referred to as a corporate predecessor for the purposes of this clause) holding an existing and active Supply Arrangement with the Method of Supply (MOS) for which the new entity subsequently applies, undergoes a divestiture which results in a portion of the corporate predecessor becoming a new entity, as defined above, Canada may, despite the Standard Instructions 2008-5.8 and General Conditions 2020-3. e, consider all the following in determining the qualification of the new entity:
 - a) The minimum years in business requirement to be met for the new entity;
 - b) The transfer of identified streams/categories, from the corporate predecessor to the new entity; and
 - c) Treating existing category substantiation information from the corporate predecessor that is already on file as that of the new entity to be used as part of the evaluation process
2. As part of the evaluation process of the new entity, the new entity will, upon the request of Canada, provide all the following:
 - a) Confirmation that the corporate change does not affect the ability of the new entity to carry on the business that had been carried on by the corporate predecessor; and
 - b) Confirmation that the new entity holds and maintains the same relevant assets, undertakings, operational capability, skills and resources as the corporate predecessor required by the particular MOS (the "Required Corporate Assets"); and
 - c) Confirmation from the corporate predecessor that:
 - i. The new entity is a result of a divestiture from within the corporate predecessor; and,

- ii. The supply arrangement of the corporate predecessor will no longer include the streams/categories that are being transferred to the new entity; and,
 - iii. The corporate predecessor acknowledges that it will be required to resubmit a bid for evaluation (via the [Centralized Professional Services System \(CPSS\)](#) if it still wishes to provide those streams/categories which have been transferred to the new entity. In this scenario, it is strongly encouraged to reach out to the Method of Supply for additional guidance.
3. A financial viability assessment may be conducted by Canada if further substantiation is required, with the assistance of the Price Support Directorate.
4. The new entity must meet all the remaining mandatory criteria stipulated in the RFSa solicitation document to be issued a Supply Arrangement.

5. Corporate Changes to Suppliers
