Title – Removal and Disposal of Lead Contaminated Soil, Pennant Harbour West Pennant, Nova Scotia

This solicitation is hereby amended to provide the following questions and answers

Q1.

We are interested in going to visit the site, do we need the consultant to attend the meeting and also is the soil analysis available? We need the concentrations in order to determine where the soil can go for disposal

A1.

Public Services and Procurement Canada and the consultant will be present if a site visit is scheduled.

As the soil is excavated, it will be placed into 50 m3 stockpiles. Composite soil samples will be collected from each stockpile for lead analysis. If the lead concentration is below 1,000 ppm, the soil can be disposed of at a NS landfill. If the lead concentration is above 1,000 ppm, leachate sampling will be conducted. If the lead leachate analysis is above 5 mg/L, out of province disposal of the soil is required. If the lead leachate analysis is below 5 mg/L, disposal at a NS landfill is acceptable (NS Guidelines for Disposal of Contaminated Solids in Landfills). Section 7.0 to 7.2 of the bid form provides the estimated tonnage of material for disposal within NS and out of province.

Is there any consideration to extend the completion date? Are there any penalties within the contract if not completed on time?

Is there any consideration as to the level of protection the workers need to comply to regarding respirators, isolation areas and Specific PPE

For health and safety requirements regarding lead abatement, it is the contractor's responsibility to identify all required training, precautions, protective equipment, etc. to safely conduct the work and protect workers and others from site activities and hazards including lead in soil. All work must be completed in accordance with the requirements of the NS Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations. In addition, Section 01 35 29.13 - *Health, Safety, And Emergency Response Procedures For Contaminated Sites*, identifies the requirements for the successful contractor to provide a Health and Safety Plan including a risk or hazard analysis, personnel training, personal protective equipment, monitoring and sampling that covers all proposed work activities. It also requires the use of a competent and authorized Health and Safety Advisor and a Certified Industrial Hygienist, among other things. Public Services and Procurement Canada is to review the Health and Safety Plan and provide comments to the successful contractor.
