Amendment 003

This amendment is raised to distribute the answers to bidder questions and makes revisions to the tender package.

A. QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q5 Comment re aggregates. 1.9mm or less compacted gravel is not an available product. typically 18mm road crush or 18 mm washed rock would be used in this application
A5 PCA is not accepting product or material submission requests for approval prior to tender award. Fill and aggregate materials must be pre-approved by the Departmental Representative prior to installation (as per 5.6.2).

Pathway access to the privys must meet CSA requirements, including slope, width, maximum threshold heights.

Q6 Pathway, site grading, and final landscaping plans to be submitted to DR for review and approval prior to construction. Is PCA requesting that the contractor provide design build for site grading , landscaping and pathways? To what extent would pca expect design - is the contractor to supply surveyed existing site plans with new plan designed by geotechnical and full survey of as built conditions post construction?

A6 PCA is requesting that pathway, site grading, and final landscaping plans to be submitted to DR for review and approval prior to construction. A site survey of as-built conditions is not required. Contractor must provide a site plan that establishes appropriate site grading and drainage plan at Bow and Simpson sites. As per 5.6.1 and 5.6.2: A site plan must include appropriate area grading and drainage plan.

Q7 Is there a geotechnical report of subsurface conditions available for this project ? **A7** No.

Q8 is there a site plan available showing the exact extent of the work described in 5.5.1 to be performed

A8 No.

As per SOW and reference documents and photos provided;

- Bow Lake site: demolish existing privy and supply and install new pre-cast vault privy in same location; re-establishing existing accessible paths with appropriate slope and drainage plan.
- Simpson Trailhead site: install new pre-cast vault privy with accessible paths with appropriate slope and drainage plan.

ADD: Vault size capacity to be minimum of 5800 litres (1500 US Gallons).
