## 2. Statement of Work CHANGES/ ADDITIONS TO STATEMENT OF WORK ITEMS

#### Revise 1.0 as follows:

Parks Canada Agency (PCA) is seeking a qualified, experienced contractor to demolish and replace an existing aged privy and vault at Bow Lake South in Banff National Park, and to remove an unused horse ramp and construct a new vault and privy at the Simpson River Trailhead in Kootenay National Park. This work is to be completed by November 30, 2022.

### Add:

5.3.6 Removal of horse ramp at Simpson River site. Removal of  $\sim$  20 cubic metres of vegetation and soil, treated wood framing. All materials to be disposed of outside of the park.

## **Revise 5.4 as follows:**

**5.4** Supply and installation of two new 2-hole vault toilets as per contractor supplied shop drawings and specifications. One at Bow Lake South and one at Simpson River Trailhead. One 2-hole vault toilet at Bow Lake South picnic site and one 1-hole vault toilet at Simpson River Trailhead site.

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## Add:

**7.10** Vault for Simpson River site to follow Alberta Sewage Systems Standards of Practice 2021, must be located 10m from the river and creek, and the opening into the vault must be a minimum of 150 mm above the surrounding finished ground surface to prevent surface water runoff from entering the tank.

## **Revise 11.1 as follows:**

**11.1** Engineer-stamped drawings and specifications for two 2-hole vault toilet buildings for Simpson River and Bow Lake locations. One 2-hole vault toilet building at Bow Lake South picnic site and one 1-hole vault toilet at Simpson River Trailhead site. Based on the referenced drawings for 1-hole and 2-hole privy structure.
