DESCRIPTION OF THE REQUIREMENT:

This bid solicitation is being issued to satisfy the requirement of the Department of Foreign Affairs, Trade and Development Canada (DFATD) the "Client" under the framework of the Supply Arrangement for Task-Based Professional Services (TSPS).



Global Affairs Canada (GAC) requires the services of a Monitor to assess the performance of the “Strengthening Civil Society in Myanmar” international development assistance project implemented by Inter Pares. In general, the Monitor will support GAC and Inter Pares in ensuring effective and efficient implementation and management of the project, with the ultimate goal of contributing to better development results. Specifically, the Monitor will:

- i. assess the progress in planning and achieving results including gender equality integration and relevance of the existing logic model and performance measure framework of the project;
- ii. provide feedback on project plans, strategies and reports;
- iii. analyze and facilitate coordination between this project and other GAC-funded health projects in Myanmar; ensuring coherence and complementarity of GAC’s health-sector portfolio in Myanmar;
- iv. report all observations and findings to GAC.

The intent of this solicitation is to establish one (1) contract.

MAXIMUM FUNDING:

The total maximum funding available for the contract resulting from the bid solicitation is CAN **\$330,000.00** Goods and Services Tax or Harmonized Sales Tax extra, as appropriate.
