This requirement is open only to those who can deliver Standard Defensive Driving Training and Off-Road Defensive Driving Training in Calgary, Alberta.



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Description of Work:

This contract will provide the Canada Energy Regulator (CER) staff with a common understanding of safe driving habits and techniques and to provide them the opportunity to apply learnings in a practical (in vehicle) situation. All CER staff who drive while performing work for the CER require a standard defensive driving course.

Staff travelling to field locations where they may travel off road require Off-Road (4x4) driver training. These requirements are categorized as risk-based training in the NEB Occupational Health and Safety Training Standard.

Standard Defensive Driving: To provide CER staff with a common understanding of safe driving habits and techniques and to provide them the opportunity to apply learnings in a practical (in-vehicle) situation. The 1-day training will cover standard safe road/highway driving techniques.

Off Road/Defensive Driving: To provide CER staff with a common understanding of safe driving habits and techniques and to provide them the opportunity to apply learnings in a practical (in vehicle) situation. The 1.5-day training will cover standard safe road/highway driving techniques as well as an off-road component which teach general 4x4 driving skills.
