The reasons for this amendment 006 are:

A) To provide the following notice to industry:

In order to provide industry with the ability to raise any questions or concerns they may have in an open forum (through a virtual meeting), PSPC is scheduling a meeting for 2 hours on September 6, 2022, at 10:00 for the purpose of additional industry engagement. While participation in this meeting is not a mandatory requirement for submitting a bid in response to the solicitation, all potential suppliers will have the opportunity to participate and provide comments. Potential suppliers may also simply choose to submit their questions using the Enquiries Process.

During the virtual meeting, representatives from both PSPC and DND will be present in order to hear any questions or concerns from potential suppliers. PSPC and DND will then issue a written summary of the questions and concerns raised and Canada's response, together with any associated amendments to the bid solicitation. PSPC and DND will be seeking during the industry meeting to understand any question or concerns that are raised, but will not be responding to the questions or concerns during the meeting.

Any potential supplier interested in participating in this meeting should email the Contracting Authority at diego.votano@tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca, so that the Contracting Authority can forward the virtual meeting link.

In order to provide time to respond to existing questions or concerns, to hold this meeting and issue the summary and responses, Canada is extending the bid closing date until 22 September 2022.
