QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Question 10	Regarding 4.1.1 Mandatory Technical Criteria M5. It is submitted that the exercise delivery team cannot adequately facilitate a discussion-based exercise for an IMS at an adequate level without the facilitators being qualified to instruct at the I-400 level. Recommend that consideration be given to change "or" to "and the" in the first sentence.
Answer 10	TC is amending first sentence in 4.1.1 Mandatory Technical Criteria M5 as follow "The bidder must demonstrate that at least one of the Bidder's exercise design and delivery team members is qualified by an ICS Canada Authority Having Jurisdiction in a province or territory, or by an ICS Canada Agency Authority Having Jurisdiction to instruct ICS I-300 (at minimum) and I-400 (preferred)."
Question 11	TC uses 2 facilitators for all virtual ICS training in order to provide an optimum student experience. In addition, many clients require a team of two facilitators for in-person discussion-based exercises for a more dynamic and engaging execution. What is the minimum team size for virtual and in-person exercises?
Answer 11	TC requires 2 facilitators for virtual and in-person exercises. It is expected that the minimum number of active engaged TC players will not be less than ten (10) and the minimum number of TC observers will not be less than eight (8) depending on the region of delivery.
Question 12	Could you please advise if there is a deadline for submitting questions to the Crown, or should we assume it is five business days prior to closing?
