2. Questions & Answers

Q1: When it comes to specific winch components, what will need to be replaced/ refurbished?

A1: Parks Canada and the successful vendor will have a case-by-case discussion.

Q2: What is the weight on each individual winch? Heavy and Light

A2: The light winches weigh 1300lbs each (about 590kg), the heavy winches weigh 2600lbs each (about 1179kg).

Q3: Can possible parts be shipped out with first five (5) sets?

A3: It is possible for Parks Canada to supply replacement parts. A discussion between Parks Canada and the successful vendor will occur after award.

Q4: Should all hardware be original to 100yrs ago?

A4: Components and hardware should be as original as possible. Replacement of parts/components with modern equivalents may be accepted.

Q5: Do broken parts/old parts return to TSW?

A5: Yes, at the end of the project, unused parts will be returned to Parks Canada.

Q6: What is the total shipping size?

A6: The light winches are 67" long x 48" tall x 42" wide each (170cm X 122cm X 106cm), and the heavy winches are 70" long x 50" tall x 40" wide each (178cm X 127cm X 102cm).

Q7: Each winch must have parts marked individually for re-assembly?

A7: It is up to the successful vendor to ensure the winches are re-assembled with the parts the winch arrived with.
