## C. Questions and Answers

**Q6** Which building has plastering work occurring? **A6** Only Big House

Q7 When the crown molding goes back on does it has to tie into the corner?

**A7** Crown molding is to be attached to the wall and the ceilings using historic cut nails which Parks Canada is supplying, and GRK screws which are to be supplied by the contractor. The corners of each crown molding should fit tightly together when installed.

Q8 Do we want visible cracks in the walls to filled?

**A8** Yes visible cracks in the walls are to be filled. During the work this will be discussed onsite with Departmental Representative.

**Q9** Does the hole in the ceiling in the Colville Bedroom require Veneer basecoat and top coat plaster finish over top?

**A9** No it does not. Patch to match surrounding/ existing ceiling. This ceiling was not done correctly previously. It will not be repaired the same as the ceiling in the parlour, dining room and the study.

**Q10** Sequence of Work Question

**A10** When installing the crown molding, the crown molding is to be reinstalled first and then the plaster is to be patched up to it to create a seamless finish.

**Q11** Where the plaster is delaminating due to damage, is it to be repaired? le. In areas such as in the SW corner of the study up at the top of the wall where the majority of the water leak occurred.

**A11** Yes the damaged plaster is to be removed and then new plaster is to be installed. Contractor is to not plaster over top of plaster in poor condition.

**Q12** What is the end look that Parks Canada wants on plaster surfaces?

**A12** A flat finish is desired. Walls and ceilings aren't to be perfect but are to have some slight variations to ensure it matches the historic character of the building. Mock up to be done and approved by Departmental Representative prior to conducting all repairs.

# A13 Sequence of Work Question

**A13** Heat panels should not be turned on until the plaster ceiling repairs are completed to avoid damaging the plaster. Trade was advised to communicate with their general contractor regarding this question.

**Q14** In the sprinkler spec it states that all fittings for pipe 2" and under are to be threaded. However, when doing the walk through yesterday I noticed lots of Victaulic grooved fittings on site. Will we have the ability to use Victaulic couplings with flush seal gaskets as well as outlet tee's on the piping? **A14** Groove fittings may be used for pipe fittings 1 inch and larger. They require flush seat gaskets.
