2. SCOPE

2.1. Introduction

The Regulatory Operations and Enforcement Branch (ROEB) delivers quality compliance and enforcement, and complementary scientific programs to inform and protect Canadians from health risks associated with products, substances and the environment. As a science-based regulator, we play a stewardship role that seeks to combine the best evidence with the most effective tools to protect and promote the health of all Canadians through regulatory and policy expertise that are trusted in Canada and internationally.

2.2. Objectives of the Requirement

The Transformation office, within the Planning and Operations Directorate in ROEB, intends to stabilize, modernize and transform the way ROEB delivers their programs and services to ensure the very best value. As such, ROEB plans to continue investing in various digital transformation projects that specifically leverage the Microsoft Power Platform to support the development and implementation of existing and/or new solutions leveraging this technology (e.g. identifying the requirements, performing impact analysis and developing technical architectures of business enabling technologies.) The expected outcome is to fully support regulatory responsibilities, improve user experience, and improve customer service for its clients and stakeholders.

To achieve these goals and objectives, Health Canada (HC) has a requirement for up to three (3) TBIPS Level 2 Technical Architect, and three (3) TBIPS Level 2 Application/Software Architect to support the development and configuration of the HC implementation of Microsoft 365 Power Platform.
