Bidders' questions and responses from Canada

Question 1: Is the contractor permitted to use the facilities for external catered events which are not part of the scope of this project.? For example, off premise private or corporate events or in support of other contractor operated sites.

Response 1: No, the contractor will never be allowed to use the Correctional Service of Canada facilities for any other off premise private or corporate events or in support of other contractor operated sites.

Question 2: Can you provide the amount of cash sales generated from staff at the site?

Response 2: No I cannot provide a \$ amount as it really depends on the number of staff on site who choose to purchase a meal from the contractor.

Question 3: Can you advise how many graduation ceremony dinners are provided by the contractor annually and what the revenue was from the events (as per task authorizations?)

Response 3: The contractor will provide 9 graduation ceremony dinners annually. I cannot provide a \$ value in regards to the revenue as it will fluctuate for each dinner.

Question 4: How many of the graduation ceremony dinners were off site?

Response 4: All 9 graduation ceremony dinners are done off site.

Question 5: Were CSC staff used to serve all meals at the graduation events or was the contractor required to provide service staff?

Response 5: CSC staff and recruits are used to serve the graduation ceremony dinner.

Question 6: If there are cash revenues generated at the site, is the contractor required to disclose the revenues as part of this agreement?

Response 6: No the contractor is not required to disclose the cash sale revenues as part of this agreement

Question 7: Please provide a breakdown of the number of meals served during weekdays. (as per task authorizations)

Response 7: The estimated number of weekday meals is shown as the estimated usage in Annex "B".

Question 8: Please provide a breakdown the number of meals served on weekends and stat holidays. (as per task authorizations)

Response 8: The estimated number of weekend meals is shown as the estimated usage in Annex "B".

Question 9: Please provide a breakdown of the number of special dietary meals provided (as per task authorization.)

Response 9: The estimated number of special dietary meals meals is shown as the estimated usage in Annex "B".

Question 10: Canada's total liability to the Contractor under the Contract must not exceed \$4,122,396.00, does this include the option year or just the initial 3 year term?

Response 10: The total liability of \$4,122,396.00 is for the firm portion of the Contract only and does not include the option years.

Question 11: For all meals served to any Diner other than Recruits, including Graduation ceremony dinner, it is the Contractor's responsibility to collect payment.

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Response 11: Yes it is the Contractor's responsibility to collect payment for all meals served to any Diner other than Recruits, including the Graduation ceremony dinner.

Question 12: Are the number of confirmed meals guaranteed for each training period.

Response 12: No the number of meals per training period will fluctuate depending on the number of recruits on site in each cohort.
