- Attendees will be required to meet at the Main Terminal Building between 12:30 and 13:00.
 - Start time of the vessel viewing is 13:00.
 - Release document and attendance sheet must be signed by each attendee prior to boarding the vessel.
 - Parking information: On-site parking available.
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The information provided in the SOW with respect to the condition of the vessel is the best information available to CANADA. Bidders are responsible to make their own assessment and ensure the accuracy of such information.

Attendees will be allowed to take any tests, samples, measurements, etc. that will aid them in better understanding the scope of work.

IMPORTANT: The vessel is not properly lit, ventilated and contain various types of Hazardous Materials/Wastes.

All attendees will receive a safety brief and must sign a release form acknowledging that touring the vessel is done at their own risk in advance of the vessel viewing.

Canada will not be supplying any safety gear or lighting equipment. Attendees are required to provide their own lighting device and safety equipment suitable for touring the vessel. **Hard hat, safety boots, lighting device and personal air/gas monitors are mandatory**, and it is recommended that attendees bring and wear the following during the vessel viewing:

- eye protection/goggles; and
- coveralls.
