 - Reproduction and delivery costs of drawings, CADD files, specifications and other technical documentation specified in the TOR;

- Standard office expenses: Photocopying, computers, internet, cellular phones, long-distance telephone calls and faxing (including that between the Consultant's main office and branch offices and between the Consultant's offices and other team members' offices).

- Any other expense identified in the TOR that the NCC will not pay for.

The following disbursements are not to be included in the hourly rates. When preapproved by the NCC Design Lead they will be reimbursed to the consultant at actual cost or as described below:

- o Extraordinary reproduction and delivery costs of drawings, documents, presentation material, CADD files, specifications and other Technical Documentation, to comply with NCC requests;
- o Extraordinary transportation costs for material samples and models additional to that specified in the Terms of Reference;
- o Fees for approvals and permits to conduct field investigations and material testing;
- o Extraordinary travel and accommodation requirements requested by the NCC shall be reimbursed in accordance with the current Treasury Board Travel Policy;
- o Other extraordinary disbursements provided they are:
 - reasonably incurred by the Consultant
 - related to the services required for a call-up

In all such cases, extraordinary requirements should be described and estimated in the Terms of Reference for the call-up, or, if their need is only identified during the call-up, formalized and approved in writing in advance by the NCC Design Lead.

• All payable disbursements must be itemized and supported by receipts where possible.
