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**SOLICITATION AMENDMENT 002 IS RAISED TO:**

**1. Add the following to PART 5 – CERTIFICATIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION of the RFSO**

**5.2.4 Security Requirements – Required Documentation**

In accordance with the requirements of the Contract Security Program of Public Works and Government Services Canada (<http://www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/esc-src/introduction-eng.html>), the Offeror must provide a completed Contract Security Program Application for Registration (AFR) form or a completed Initial International Security Screening (IISS) form to be given further consideration in the procurement process.

Offerors are reminded to obtain the required security clearance and, as applicable, security capabilities promptly. As indicated above, Offerors who do not provide all the required information at bid closing will be given the opportunity to complete any missing information from the AFR or the IISS form within a period set by the Standing Offer Authority. If that information is not provided within the timeframe established by the Standing Offer Authority (including any extension granted by the Standing Offer Authority in its discretion), or if Canada requires further information from the Offeror in connection with assessing the request for security clearance (i.e., information not required by the AFR or the IISS form), the Offeror will be required to submit that information within the time period established by the Standing Offer Authority, which will not be less than 48 hours. If, at any time, the Offeror fails to provide the required information within the timeframe established by the Standing Offer Authority, its offer will be declared non-compliant.

**2. Answer the following question received from a supplier:**

Q1: After a review of the RFSO section 6 and 7, kindly confirm the only requirement for security clearance is the contractor must be a legal entity in a NATO country if not a Canadian company. Additionally, should we complete the CONTRACT SECURITY PROGRAM (CSP) INITIAL INTERNATIONAL SECURITY SCREENING FORM (last 5 pages of the attached solicitation) with our proposal, or after award of the contract?

A1: As indicated in Part 7A – Standing Offer, the Foreign recipient Contractor must be from a country within the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), the European Union (EU) or from a country with which Canada has an international bilateral security instrument.

Contractor's are encouraged to review Part 6 – Security, Financial and Insurance Requirements and Part 7 – Standing Offer and Resulting Contract Clauses, in conjunction with the Security Requirements Check List, in their entirety for full details of the security requirements.
