Linak DPF height adjustable controls with memory buttons.


Stream 6, Item 2 description, replace with:

Linak DP height adjustable controls with memory buttons.

Questions and Answers

- Q1: Can the bidder respond to Stream 11 partially as the bidder doesn't have access to all the products specified on this stream?
- R1: No. The bidder must confirm that they can provide all goods outlined in each stream(s) as described in Appendix "A" Various Streams.
- Q2: Will the Senate accept a price hold for no longer than 1 year and a discount percentage hold for the remainder of the contract OR a discount percentage hold for the entire contract?
- R2: No. The prices are to be provided as specified in the RFSO.
- Q3: On Stream 12, will the Senate accept the TCL360 arms instead of the TSWVLT arms, as they're no longer manufactured? The TCL360 arms have all the same functions that the TSWVLT arms did.
- R3: If the TSWVLT arms are no longer manufactured and TCL360 is the closest alternative with all of the same functions, yes, the Senate accepts this substitution.

Q4: On Stream 2, FlexFab is no longer in existence, it was purchased by Lincora. Lincora only provides lockers and no longer provides the products listed. Does the bidder have permission to provide an alternate?

R4: If FlexFab no longer exists, we are willing to accept a substitution. The substitution must be a very close match to the description of Flexfab items. Please add a note stating "Colour and finish to be selected when ordered".
