# Amendment 002 is raised to address questions received from the industry and hereby revise the solicitation.

Q1. Would the Crown consider removing the minimum six-month requirement for CM1 and CRT1 to allow Bidders to demonstrate a broader range of highly relevant projects?

R1. Please see revised appendix 1 – Evaluation criteria. Revised criteria are in yellow highlights.

Q2. Given the scope of the work and the current health and work climate, and the fact many Bidders may want to affect resources located in different Canadian regions, would the Crown consider allowing staff with the required security clearance level to perform work remotely via telework when the situation allows it?

R2. All work under this contract will be completed remotely. The Contractor is not required to perform any work on-site.

Q3. For Resource Mandatory Criteria RM1-RM4, the RFP states that "Proof of education must be provided." Can you clarify what proof should be provided beyond details of the academic degree, institution, and year?

R3. Please see revised appendix 1 – Evaluation criteria. Revised criteria are in yellow highlights.

Q4. For the scoring of the Resource Point Rated Criteria (RTI-RT4), are projects required to demonstrate the years of experience to obtain the maximum points—or could sample projects be provide along with a general description of responsibilities and work performed? If indeed specific projects are required to demonstrate the full timeframe of stated experience, can you clarify how bidders should address the Project Leader/Executive (RT1)?

R4. Projects are required to demonstrate the years of experience and bidders are also encouraged to provide a general description of responsibilities and work performed. The Project Leader/Executive is asked to demonstrate their experience in any combination of the four mentioned subject areas. This could include experience overseeing, leading, facilitating, or participating in projects that cover the subject area.

## 4.2.1 Highest Combined Rating of Technical Merit and Price

- 1. To be declared responsive, a bid must:
  - a. comply with all the requirements of the bid solicitation;
  - b. meet all mandatory criteria;
  - c. obtain the required minimum of 64 points overall for the bidder / corporate technical evaluation criteria which are subject to point rating. The rating is performed on a scale of 100 points.
  - d. Bids not meeting 4.2.1 (c) will not be considered for the resource point rated technical evaluation.



- e. Obtain the required minimum of 50 points overall for the resource technical evaluation criteria. The rating is performed on a scale of 76 points.
- 2. Bids not meeting (a) or (b) or (c) or (d) or (e) will be declared non-responsive.
- 3. The selection will be based on the highest responsive combined rating of technical merit and price. The ratio will be 60 % for the technical merit and 40 % for the price.
- 4. To establish the technical merit score, the overall technical score for each responsive bid will be determined as follows: total number of points obtained / maximum number of points available multiplied by the ratio of 60 %.
- 5. To establish the pricing score, each responsive bid will be prorated against the lowest evaluated price and the ratio of 40%.
- 6. For each responsive bid, the technical merit score and the pricing score will be added to determine its combined rating.
- Neither the responsive bid obtaining the highest technical score nor the one with the lowest evaluated price will necessarily be accepted. The responsive bid with the highest combined rating of technical merit and price will be recommended for award of a contract.

The table below illustrates an example where all three bids are responsive and the selection of the contractor is determined by a 60/40 ratio of technical merit and price, respectively. The total available points equal 135 and the lowest evaluated price is \$45,000 (45).

## **APPENDIX "1" - EVALUATION CRITERIA**

Bidders are advised to address these criteria in the following order and in sufficient depth in their proposals to enable a thorough assessment. NRCan's assessment will be based solely on the information contained within the proposal. NRCan may confirm information or seek clarification from bidders.



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Bidders are advised that only listing experience without providing any supporting data to describe responsibilities, duties and relevance to the criteria will not be considered demonstrated for the purpose of this evaluation.

The Bidder should provide complete details as to where, when (month and year) and how (through which activities/ responsibilities) the stated qualifications/experience were obtained. Experience gained during formal education shall not be considered work experience. All criteria for work experience shall be obtained in a legitimate work environment as opposed to an educational setting. Co-op terms are considered work experience provided they are related to the required services.

Bidders are also advised that the month(s) of experience listed for a project whose time frame overlaps that of another referenced project will only be counted once. For example: project one time frame is July 2001 to December 2001; project two time frame is October 2001 to January 2002; the total months of experience for these two project references is seven (7) months.

If clarification regarding the supporting documentation is needed, the Contracting Authority will notify the Bidder that they must provide supporting documentation within two (2) business days following notification. Failure to comply with the request of the Contracting Authority within that time period, will deem the bid nonresponsive and the bid will be given no further consideration.
