General

Question and Answer

Q3: Could the Senate of Canada clarify what level of organizational and personnel clearance is required for the level of “site access” to the Senate? Is there a PSPC/Contract Security Program (CSP) security clearance (i.e., reliability or secret) that would be considered equivalent to Senate level of “site access”?

A3: A valid security clearance is a condition of any Senate contract and is required for all individuals with whom the Senate may need to share or provide access to sensitive or classified information, assets, or facilities.

The Senate works in collaboration with other federal department to determine equivalent security clearance levels between the Senate and other federal institutions that have issued a security clearance. This is conducted on a case-by-case basis.

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
