B) Answer the bidders' questions (2-5)

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 2

For the mandatory criterion M2 on p.20, regarding the attendee experience you are asking that one (1) virtual, inperson or hybrid events, that has been a large-scale (>1000 attendees), bilingual event that took place in Canada, and was accessible and inclusive for participants. Are we able to present an event example which meets these requirements but will take place in <u>February 2023</u>, which is prior to the annual Canadian Congress on Disability Inclusion (CCDI) in May 2023?



Answer 2

As per the instructions outlined in M2 of the Mandatory Technical Criteria, the Bidder's relevant experience must have taken place prior to the bid closing date. ESDC cannot evaluate the Bidder's potential or expected experience for pending events (i.e. experience and skills not yet obtained for events that have not yet happened).

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Question 3

If this event (in February 2023) is presented to fulfill the requirements of (M2), will we receive the same consideration when scoring points in the R1 Bidder Experience section on p. 23?

Answer 3

As per the instructions outlined in R1 of the Point-Rated Technical Criteria, the Bidder's relevant projects must have taken place within two (2) years prior to the bid closing date. ESDC cannot evaluate the Bidder's potential or expected experience for pending events (i.e. experience and skills not yet obtained for events that have not yet happened).

Question 4

As indicated on p.56, Annex "C", Basis of Payment, section 1. Initial Contract Period - Year 1, are the CCDI event dates going to be for 3 days on 22-24 May 2023?

Answer 4

The Canadian Congress on Disability Inclusion (CCDI) for 2023 will tentatively take place on May 24-26, 2023 (3 days).

Question 5

We are inquiring regarding M1 of the Mandatory Technical Criteria. Our company is 6 years old, but we have decades of experience within the event and conference industry. Does this automatically exclude us from bidding (as M1 states we must have been in business for a minimum of ten (10) years), or are we able to demonstrate via our proposal that we are qualified and have ample relevant experience?

Answer 5

As per the instruction outlined in M1 of the Mandatory Technical Criteria, the Bidder (i.e. the firm) must have been in business for a minimum of ten (10) years prior to the bid closing date. Of those 10 years, the Bidder must have at least five (5) years specializing in the provision of virtual and in-person event management services. ESDC will not evaluate Bidders that do not meet this requirement.

ESDC will evaluate the experience of the proposed resource (qualified person) that will lead the project on behalf of the firm in M3 of the Mandatory Technical Criteria. All submitted projects must have been done on behalf of the current firm; projects submitted from other firms will not be accepted.

All other terms and conditions of the solicitation remain the same.
