Q1

Can we be provided with sample materials or finished products that DND is currently using?

A1

The Request for Proposal Document, including Annex – Statement of Requirement and Annex – Mandatory Technical Criteria is detailed enough that suppliers should be able to provide bids using the information found within it.

Q2

Please advise regarding the particular applications of these units.

R2

The machine shop has an old bench top Dot peener which should be replaced under the life cycle management. We require this machine for marking unique identifiers on all submarine parts we produce. The handheld equipment will allow our operation to be more versatile in how we complete our work requests.

Q3

For the marking area, please confirm that 100 mm is the minimum and the products with higher marking width (i.e. 160 mm) are acceptable.

R3

The machine's minimum marking size must be between 90mm and 110mm.

Q4

Please advise if a handheld unit with a weight of 3.2 Kg is acceptable.

R4

We are willing to increase the maximum weight of the handheld unit including the cable to 3.4Kg.

8) Electrical Certification

- a) The electrical equipment being supplied must be certified by an acceptable electrical certified organization. The following certified organizations are acceptable. The electrical equipment must bear a label from one of these organizations in order to be recognized as approved.

- c) NOTE: Labels from all organizations above (with the exception of CSA and ULC), must be accompanied by a small "c" at the eight o'clock position or Canadian Standard number to indicate the product has been certified to the Canadian Standard.
- d) Electrical equipment that is not certified by one of the above agencies can only be accepted if the equipment is "field" inspected and labelled by the Canadian Standards Association (CSA), QPS/Entela, Intertek Testing Services, MET Laboratories, TUV America Inc., Underwriters Laboratories of Canada under the Special Inspection Program. This inspection must take place before equipment delivery to FMF Cape Scott unless otherwise discussed and agreed upon between the vendor and FMFCS, and a copy of verification documentation report must accompany the machine with delivery.
