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**This amendment is raised to answer questions from industry.**

Q1. Are there is any environmental aspects to this RFI such as soil samples, water samples, containment and MOE?

A1. None required by Transport Canada. Any additional permits that may be required are the responsibility of the contractor.

Q2. What is the time frame? Does it need to be removed in a certain time such as spring, summer, fall or winter for things such as pedestrians and or water fluctuations?

A2. Upon awarding of a contract, the work will need to be completed before March 31, 2024.

Q3. What would be the time frame? Something like one week, or more like 3 months from start of project?

A3. The length of the work will be determined by the contractor and agreed upon by Transport Canada.

Q4. Has there been any thought for this project to be a salvage and recovery of lake bottom or is it just remove salvage and leave lake bed as how the salvage was removed?

A4. Yes, the bed of the waterway will need to be restored if there are any berms or piles created as a result of the removal.

Q5. Are there any known environmental risks?

A5. To be determined by the contractor.

Q6. Who will be responsible for permits?

A6. The contractor will be responsible for obtaining all permits required to perform the work. It is the contractor's responsibility to contact any other possible authorities and obtain any other permits required for the completion of this work.
