ACAN no. 1000403996

An Advanced Contract Award Notice (ACAN) is a public notice indicating to the supplier community that a department or agency intends to award a contract for goods, services or construction to a pre-identified supplier, thereby allowing other suppliers to signal their interest in bidding, by submitting a statement of capabilities. If no supplier submits a statement of capabilities that meet the requirements set out in the ACAN, on or before the closing date and time stated in the ACAN, the contracting officer may then proceed with the award to the pre-identified Contractor.

1. Definition of requirement:

The Canada Border Service Agency (CBSA) has a requirement to rent an outdoor firing range facility for Border Services Officers' firearms training.

1.1 Objectives:

The CBSA requires rental services of a firearms range facility in Eastern Ontario in order to provide armed Border Services Officers with firearms training, as per prescribed standard policies.

1.2 Tasks and Deliverables:

The tasks and deliverables the Contractor must complete include, but are not limited to the following:

- Provision of firearms range for approximately 40 days per year.
- Provide safety procedures.

1.3 Range Requirements:

The following Range criteria are required to be provided by the Contractor:

- Access to washroom facilities
- Range must allow for the discharge of 9mm (9 x 19) Calibre 147 Grain Jacket Hollow Point Ammunition, 147 Grain Full Metal Jacket Ammunition and FX Marking cartridges (ie. Simunition) and blank ammunition
- Allow for the use of CBSA-supplied silhouette targets, protective vests and duty holsters
- Allow for the install of a storage container for miscellaneous range supplies. CBSA must be able to secure storage space with a padlock
- Free parking for a minimum of 12 CBSA vehicles
- Allow for the minimum of 8 shooters with a shooting distance of 25 metres from the firing line to the target stand not including bullet traps
- Range allows for passage of instructors behind shooters on firing line (minimum 4 feet depth)
- Range must allow lateral movement, parallel to the back-stop as well as movement at approximately a 45 degree angle to the back-stop
- Range must allow the use of Agency owned or provide suitable barricades and target stands
- Range must allow prone shooting positions
- An area away from the firing line should be available for clean-up
- Provide confirmation of license to operate the range according to the Chief Firearms Office, Royal Canadian Mounted Police Federal Regulations and all applicable Guidelines/Legislation are met to operate a firearms range

1.4 Constraints:

- Facility must be available to rent for full (8 hour) and half day (4 hour) periods
- Range must be available Monday to Friday between 7:30-16:00 ET
- Live-fire must be allowed between the hours of 9:00-16:00 ET

- CBSA staff must be the sole occupants of the range on the scheduled usage days, with no club members or members of the general public on the range assigned to the Agency
- Firing range location must be within a distance of 40 km of the CBSA NOR Campus office at 2270 St-Laurent Blvd in Ottawa, Ontario
- The Contractor must provide flexibility within their schedule to book time at various points during each month. As use is varied, dependent on CBSA training requirements, days will be scheduled at minimum 30-days in advance by CBSA. Requests to use the facility with less than 30-days' notice will be considered by the Contractor and use outside of previously prescribed hours may be accommodated based on availability

1.5 Location of Work:

The Contractor's place of business, must be within 40 km of CBSA - NOR Campus office at 2270 St-Laurent Blvd in Ottawa, Ontario.

1.6 Security Requirements:

There is no security requirements associated with this requirement.

2. Minimum Essential Requirements:

Any interested suppliers must demonstrate by way of a statement of capabilities that they meet all of the following requirements:

- **2.1** The supplier must demonstrate that they have a minimum of two (2) years providing outdoor firearm range services with the required minimum distances to 9mm (9 x 19) Calibre 147 Grain Jacket Hollow Point Ammunition, 147 Grain Full Metal Jacket Ammunition and FX Marking cartridges (ie. Simunition) and blank ammunition.
- **2.2** The supplier must demonstrate that they have a firearms range within 40 km of CBSA NOR Campus office at 2270 St-Laurent Blvd in Ottawa, Ontario.
- **2.3** The supplier must demonstrate that they have a license to operate the range according to the Chief Firearms Office, Royal Canadian Mounted Police Federal Regulations and all applicable Guidelines/Legislation are met to operate a firearms range.
- **2.4** The supplier must demonstrate that they have a firing range facility that meets the range requirements outlined in Section 1.3 above and the CBSA Standards on Firing Ranges (refer to PDF attachment).

3. Applicability of the Trade Agreement(s) to the Procurement:

The contract period is from April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2025, with the option to extend the contract by four (4) additional one-year periods.
