

# Appendix B: Bid evaluation criteria

# Canadian Construction Materials Centre request for standing offers for technical services by subject matter experts

# **Objective**

Award one or more standing offers to relevant subject matter experts who will provide technical services to support the operation of the Canadian Construction Materials Centre (CCMC).

### Bid evaluation criteria

Standing offers will be awarded to all bidders who meet the mandatory requirements (see below) and bidders must provide the following documents for each of their relevant experts (i.e., staff, personnel):

- a completed Appendix D: Expertise matrix, and
- a well-organized Curriculum vitae (CV).

### Mandatory requirements

The above documents must demonstrate that each expert meets the following two (2) mandatory requirements:

1. The contractor must provide evidence supporting a minimum of seven (7) years of experience in one or more of the following technical domains with detailed supporting references (e.g., publications, work completed, areas of study and/or other substantial support for expertise in the domain):

#### **Building product functions:**

- 1. Air leakage control
- 2. Backing/fastening support
- 3. Building services and utilities
- 4. Dampproofing
- 5. Falling, tripping, slipping protection
- 6. Fire protection
- 7. Heat and moisture dissipation
- 8. Heat transfer control
- Indoor air quality protection
- 10. Moisture resistance/waterproof layer
- 11. Protection of insulation

- 12. Soil gas control
- 13. Sound transmission control
- 14. Structural capacity
- 15. Structural integrity
- 16. Subfloor imperfection mitigation
- 17. Water drainage
- 18. Water ingress protection
- 19. Water vapour diffusion control
- 20. Waterproofing
- 21. Wind barrier

#### **Building product materials:**

- 22. Cellulose and paper
- 23. Concrete
- 24. Geotextiles
- 25. Metals

- 26. Polymers and plastics
- 27. Resins and adhesives
- 28. Stone, brick and masonry
- 29. Wood and wood composites

In addition to the above technical domains, contractors are encouraged to include their expertise in other relevant construction product categories, which would support them in receiving a standing offer (see Appendix D: Expertise matrix).





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2. The contractor must provide evidence supporting a minimum of five (5) years of experience in Canadian-relevant conformity assessment and/or standardization and/or codes development (bids must include a detailed list of work, responsibilities and/or involvement in codes/standards technical committees).

Successful contractors meeting the above mandatory requirements will be awarded a standing offer. Call-ups on an asneeded basis will be selected according to the call-up selection criteria at **Appendix C – Call-up selection criteria**.
