QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS #1

QUESTION #1

Is the intent of the proposal for the bidder to create a catastrophe model that is able to calculate AALs for the named perils?

ANSWER #1

The intent of the proposal_RFP is for the bidder to create a methodology that is transferable for the calculation of AAL values across all natural hazards, and that the bidder would then leverage to calculate AAL values for the two named perils. The methodology must be able to calculate AALs for the named perils, but it also must be transferable across all hazards so that it can be used on a repeatable basis by Public Safety Canada in the future for additional hazards.

Public Safety is using deterministic risk assessments – or 'scenario-based' risk assessments – that focus on the impact of a single hazard scenario. Deterministic risk assessment is useful for hazards where limited or no probabilistic modelling exists.

QUESTION #2

Is the intent for the bidder to utilize various catastrophe models to come up with a methodology to utilize said models for AAL, Probabilities, etc.

ANSWER #2

The bidder will be expected to leverage various models and data sources, which can include catastrophe models, to derive a methodology for the creation of AAL values across natural hazards, along with detailed step-by-step information on the sources that were used.

QUESTION #3

If the former, could we do a partnership for a bid?

ANSWER #3

Joint ventures are permitted. Per section 2 – Definitions in Part 1 – General Information of the RFP, "The Bidder submitting a proposal may, however consist of several firms putting one proposal together as a joint venture. In the case of a joint venture, the combined experience of the firms forming the joint venture will be considered for the purposes of determining the Bidder's compliance with the Mandatory Requirements."

QUESTION #4

Would the Crown please extend the closing date by one (1) week?

ANSWER #4

Canada extended the solicitation period from January 23rd, 2023 to January 30, 2023. See amendment #01 to the RFP.
