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## Solicitation Amendment No. 004

### Solicitation Amendment No. 004 is issued to:

1. Clarify a few items in Amendment 003.
  2. Address Bidders' questions or concerns.
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#### 1. Clarifications on Amendment 003

- A. The attachment package for Amendment 003 only included the English version of section 15.6 of the SOW; the French version was missing. Therefore, the French version of section 15.6 of the SOW is now included at the end of the French version of this Amendment 004.
- B. In the English version of the Amendment document, the heading "Questions after the Bidders' Conference" was omitted. Therefore:

Add: "Questions after the Bidders' Conference" above Question number 23 in the English version of Amendment 003.

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#### 2. Bidders Questions / Concerns and Canada's Responses:

**Q # 27:** The solicitation number indicated on the tender documents and on the amendments is F7049-210340/A. However, the number listed on the Statement of Work (French and English) is F7949-210340.

**R # 27:** Thank you for noting this discrepancy. Therefore, on the cover page of the Statement of Work (French and English), please:

Delete: "F7949-210340"

Insert: "F7049-210340"

**Q # 28:** With respect to the ITT document, Annex "K":

- A. Item # 10 in Table K-1, related to Integrity Provisions, requires that Declaration of Convicted Offences, or a letter stating its non-applicability must be submitted, by the Bidder and all its known subcontractors at the time of the bid closing.
- B. Item # 1 in Table K-2, related to Integrity Provisions, states that the required documentation, if applicable, must be provided by the Bidder and all its known sub-contractors at the time of bid closing.

We request that the application of these requirements be withdrawn from subcontractors, and moved to Tables K-3 and K-4 – so that they be applied after the contract award.

**R # 28:** Canada cannot accept this request. The required declarations or letters of non-applicability apply to the bidder (Supplier), its affiliates and first tier subcontractors. For clarity, please refer to the following clauses included in the ITT document on Integrity Provisions:

- Section 4.21 of the Supply Manual in item 7 of clause 1.2. Please read this section with particular attention to all paragraphs (a to g) of 4.21.3 "Contracting with subcontractors". Where paragraph "b" of this section reads:

*"Bidders are responsible for verifying the status of first tier subcontractors prior to submitting a bid that identifies first tier subcontractors and before entering into a contractual relationship with first tier subcontractors."*

- Section 01 of Standard Instructions 2003 in clause 5.1.1. Please read "01 (2016-04-04) Integrity provisions—bid".
- Section 17 of "Ineligibility and Suspension Policy" in clause 5.2.1. Please refer to [Ineligibility and Suspension Policy - Government of Canada's Integrity Regime - Accountability - PSPC \(tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca\)](https://www.pwgsc.gc.ca/ineligibility-and-suspension-policy), sections 17 and 16.

Please note that bidders are required to identify all their subcontractors (with value of their contract exceeding \$5,000) and FSRs in Annex "D"; and must obtain and submit their agreement to work on this project with the bidder.

**Q # 29:** Our insurance company is asking for an estimate of the dollar value of equipment being supplied by the CCG.

**R # 29:** The estimated value of the Government supplied materiel is included, as \$6.5M in Annex E, section E.6 (All Risk Property Insurance).

**Q # 30:** For the materiel being supplied by CCG, will CCG be responsible for them while they are in transit, until they are delivered to the shipyard?

**R # 30:** CCG confirms that they are responsible for the delivery of the CCG supplied materiel to the shipyard; which, includes the cost and liability for the shipment while in transit. However, once the materiel has arrived at the shipyard, the Contractor is responsible (manpower, lifts, and insurance) for the unloading of the materiel and their transport to their designated storage areas. Please refer to S 1.2.25 of the SOW.

**Q # 31:** In Section 12.4.3 of the SOW (Rev 1.1), paragraph 12.4.3.4.3.3 for the manufacture and installation of new foundations for the new generator sets, the provided specification and referenced documents (Drawing 5660-223-001 and DAAE027798 and the IPI DMCA00049640-a4 Black IPI) do not specify which non-destructive tests must be done on the new foundations.

Please advise whether non-destructive testing is required, which type, and all the relevant details applicable to new foundations.

**R # 31:** CCG confirms that non-destructive testing is required. Magnetic particle inspection (MPI) or Liquid Penetrant Inspection (LPI) can be used. All inspections must follow the general welding work and inspection requirements identified for this project, and comply with the applicable class rules.

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**Q # 32:** In Section 11.6.3 of the SOW (Rev 1), related to Steel Works – Helicopter Hanger, paragraph 11.6.3.11 reads: "*On the fixed section and the bulkhead section, the contractor shall replace aluminum on the lower 30 cm along the entire length of the fixed section (port and starboard) by aluminum 5086H116. The new aluminum must be identical to the existing aluminum, including the mounting holes on the bridge.*". We cannot find any documentation showing the thickness of the aluminum as well as the thickness of the vertical steel section bolted to the hangar. Therefore:

- a) Please provide reference drawings that would indicate the requested thicknesses and would also include the details of the adjacent workshop.
- b) Is it possible to know the exact length of these steel and aluminum sections to be replaced?

**R # 32:** Please note the following:

- a) CCG is looking to find the relevant drawings; they will be provided at a later date.
- b) The lengths of steel or aluminium, to be replaced, are approximately 6.5 meters on each side (Port and Stbd).

**Q # 33:** In Section 11.6.3 of the SOW (Rev 1), with respect to paragraph 11.4.3.10 – floor drain locations, please provide the insulation details for the cold room below room 206.

**R # 33:** All details for insulation can be found in drawing # 108-H-4410 Insulation Plan. All the products used must be type approved.
