QUESTION 6

E-13 Crane Renewals - 3.3.7.7. Contractor to supply and install local pushbutton controls to allow for 2 speed operation, stop and emergency stop. (Is there a schematic to reference?)

ANSWER 6

Yes there is a schematic to reference for the control wiring at the VFD in the Appendix for E-03.

The document title is "Optidrive P2 User Guide V3.08". On Page 30 the Bidder will find Control wiring to the VFD inputs.

On Page 47-48 the Bidder can find the Digital Input configuration and Control terminal functions.

CCG asks in the spec for a stop/start Pushbutton station with two speed buttons, and a stop/Emergency Stop button. Example of a unit is attached. (Picture Below)

QUESTION 8

H-13 Wet Lab Modernization (Lighting) - 3.1.3. Contractor to supply new cabling for Glamox panel lights for the science lab. This requires 3 conductor #XX AWG marine rated cable (What size cable?)

ANSWER 8

Panel lights in Science Wet Lab will be re-connected to existing supply (3 Conductor #14 AWG) currently powering lighting in this space. CCG will supply all lighting fixtures. No new cable needed for panel lighting. (Will be corrected in specification version 2)

Pot lights will require new 5 Conductor #14AWG, as listed in spec to be supplied by Contractor. Contractor to also supply one low voltage dimmer switch at lab entrance.

CCG Will supply a lighting layout for the Wet Lab. There will be 7 GSM pot lights added over the counter space perimeter. Contractor will supply the 50ft of 5 Conductor #14 AWG and Dimmer switch to complete install.

GSM (CCG Supplied)

Glamox DL 60 Pot Lights (7 Total)
4ft Panel Lights (3 Total)

Bidder to Supply:

5 Conductor #14 AWG- Qty. 50ft

QUESTION 9

H-13 Wet Lab Modernization (Flooring)

- 1) H-13 they mention filling in under the cabinets that are there with an underlayment. So that they can prep the floor to install their own epoxy. It references 6 square feet per cabinet that needs to be filled in, but doesn't specify anything else. Number of cabinets? or a total square footage that needs to be filled?

ANSWER:

CCG states known cabinet quantity to be 6. If allowing 6 square feet per cabinet. Assume 36ft to be power tool cleaned and filled as per spec.

- 2) Can you get an answer on whether or not the CCGS is satisfied to use Sub kote 1 to repair the current underlayment or fill in any holes that's there now. But then trowel Dexotex Dexscreed over all the areas to allow for a smooth finish for installation of the vinyl. We would be really saving a step between underlayment repairs and vinyl installation. Plus its an easier product to get a smooth finish with.

ANSWER:

CCG discussed with Hallmark flooring. Hallmark recommends not to defer from the spec. CCG direction to bidder is to complete bid as per spec.

QUESTION 10

E-13 Crane Renewals - 3.1.2. Clarification required for who is responsible for completing the work, Contractor or FSR?

ANSWER 10

FSR will complete all electrical cable connections, hydraulic piping and connections between the HPU and crane units/controls. Supply cable from P68 to be run by contractor.

QUESTION 11

L-03 Deckhead Panel Lighting - 1.1 Clarification required for who is responsible for supplying lighting fixtures?

ANSWER 11

CCG will supply lighting fixtures. Contractor will supply cabling and dimmers. (Paragraph 1.1 Will be revised in spec version 2)

QUESTION 12

Bidders are concerned that suppliers are proving quotes that are valid for a short period of time

ANSWER12

PSPC advised bidders to include quotes for material with bid and after contract award if pricing changes the delta will be covered by 1379

QUESTION 13

Bidders voiced concerns about long lead items that might make it in time for the refit

ANSWER 13

Long lead items to be ordered upon contract award. CCG to compile list of LLI to send to Contractor to expedite. (H-05 Electronics workshop Furniture, H-12 Cabin Furniture, H-13 Wet Lab Furniture, H-14 Hatch Renewal, E-10 Plate Coolers)

QUESTION 14

Some long lead items might require a down payment, can a progress claim form 1111 be submitted before the work starts?

ANSWER 14

PSPC advised that progress claim 1111 may be processed for money associated with Long Lead materials required
