- 4. Amend Annex A Requirement in the English version of the RFP #W6369-23-A085 to change Regular Minitip Nylon Flocked Swab with 3 mL Universal Transport Medium (UTM) to Regular and Minitip Nylon Flocked Swab with 3 mL Universal Transport Medium (UTM) and to update section 3. Specifications to clarify the accepted product options; and

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Question 1	As per Section 4.1.1.1: Mandatory Technical Criteria: Table Subsection M5 "The Bidder must demonstrate that their product, comprised of the swab and UTM, holds a Class II Medical Device License in Canada." Would the Health Canada Interim Order Approval product suffice for meeting this requirement?
Answer 1	Yes, a product approved under Interim Order No. 3 Respecting the Importation and Sale of Medical Devices for Use in Relation to COVID-19 would be acceptable to meet the requirement.
Question 2	As per Section 4.1.1.1: Mandatory Technical Criteria: Table Subsection M6:
	The Contractor must hold a valid Medical Device Establishment License covering the licensable activities within the scope of Annex A – Requirement, of the contract.
	The bidder must provide a copy of the Medical Device Establish License, or screenshot of the Medical Device Establishment license number from the Medical Device Establishment License Listing.
	Will the Government of Canada accept a Contractor bidding on this opportunity if the Contractor represent (work with) a company/Subcontractor that holds such a License?
Answer 2	Yes, prospective bidders may bid on this opportunity in partnership with other companies or subcontractors as long the goods to be supplied are authorized for sale under the Canadian Medical Device Regulations or Interim Order No. 3 respecting the importation and sale of medical devices for use in relation to COVID-19 at the time of bid submission.

2. OBJECTIVE

The Strategic Medical Countermeasures Program on behalf of the Canadian Forces Health Services Group (CF H Svcs Gp), Department of National Defence (DND), has a requirement for a supply of an initial quantity of 50,500, and optional quantity of up to 101,000 Regular and Minitip Nylon Flocked Swab with 3 mL Universal Transport Medium (UTM) for collection, transport, and preservation of clinical specimens for viral molecular diagnostic testing.

3. SPECIFICATIONS


