This may not necessitate different data but may require an updated set of data on an individual due to an ongoing review of that file. It may also include a manual query or follow-up for specific data of concern (either due to missing data or clarifications on highlighted data of concern).

MT1	The Bidder must conduct credit checks on one (1) credit database from a major consumer credit reporting agency in Canada, to provide a Consumer Credit Report.	The Bidder must provide the name of the database that will be used in support of this requirement.
	The Consumer Credit Report is to be utilized in the security screening process for the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) and Department of National Defence (DND). The report must include the consumer information as outlined in Annex "A", Statement of Work Section 14.
