2.2.1 specific requirements – The PSS must satisfy the following specific operation and configuration requirements:

DELETE:

g. The need for replacement of any components of any sub-systems throughout system lifetime must be avoided. (i.e batteries or others - dependent of final contractor system design). The PSS components must be designed and selected for a minimum 20-year design life cycle"

g. Must not need replacement of any components of any sub-systems throughout system lifetime.
 (i.e batteries or others - dependent of final contractor system design). The PSS components must be designed and selected for a minimum 20-year design life cycle"

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 5:

Is there a preference for incumbent suppliers or brands of equipment, such as batteries? If so, can these suppliers or brands in existing design be provided to include in the quotation.

Answer 5:

DND has no preference for suppliers or brands of equipment.

Question 6:

The original PSS system had both lead-acid and zinc-air batteries, with the zinc-air coming online after the lead-acid batteries lost charge after October. In the original design, do the lead acid batteries need to be replaced every year?

Answer 6:

The existing lead-acid battery bank does not need to be replaced every year.

Question 7:

Site Acceptance Tests for the trial require reports throughout the year, and a computer installed to routinely request data from the prototype. Does this computer need to be powered off the PSS system, or will there be power from CFS Alert to power the computer?

Answer 7:

This computer can be powered off the PSS system or by an existing power source available inside CFS Alert. Contractor is to allow for a minimum of 100 meters distance between the outside location of the PSS prototype and the available power source for the computer inside CFS alert. The computer must be installed in a sufficiently heated location to allow for its proper operation, either inside CFS alert or in a heated enclosure provided by the contractor within of beside the PSS system. All data communication between the PSS and the test computer must be wired. Wireless communication is not permitted at CFS Alert.

5.2 Installation Phase I

Question 8:

The RFP document says no hydrocarbon-based fuels are allowed, but Annex A says direct-methanol fuel cells may be considered. GPT considers methanol to be a hydrocarbon and direct-methanol fuel cells would output CO2 and water. Can other hydrocarbon fuels be considered, or only direct methanol?

Answer 8:

Only direct-methanol fuel cells will be considered. No other hydrocarbon fuels will be considered. Contractors shall also consider transportation restrictions for hazardous materials in its transportation plan.

Question 9:

If we submit a reference project to MA1 which was completed by a subcontractor proposed for the HADCS who completed the referenced project not under contract to (blank), will Canada evaluate it?

Answer 9:

If the proposed subcontractor is included as a subcontractor in the proposal. The referenced project to MA1 will be evaluated.

Should this subcontractor not be part of the proposal, the referenced project will not be evaluated.

Question 10:

Does 'can include the experience of any proposed subcontractor of the bidder' mean that (1) projects completed by a proposed subcontractor will only be evaluated if (blank) was the prime contractor OR (2) projects completed by a proposed subcontractor will be evaluated regardless of the prime contractor's involvement in the project referenced?

Answer 10:

If the subcontractor is included as part of the proposal, projects completed by the proposed subcontractor will be evaluated regardless of the prime contractor's involvement in the project referenced.
