Q1	We are requesting an extension of an additional week to submit our response.					
A1	SSC agrees to extend this solicitation by 1 week - from March 7, 2023 to March 14, 2023.

Q3	Poly provides pricing to bidders in USD. In order to provide cost certainty in the Annex for the option years, would SSC allow bidders to submit the Annex USD? This will mitigate exchange rate risk for all bidders.					
A3	SSC will not include provisions for exchange rate fluctuation. SSC intends on paying the fixed price and does not want to assume the upside or downside of exchange rate fluctuations on an ongoing basis.					
Q4	In 2020, SACC 4001 was amended to allow for Certified "like new" parts. Poly is unable to comply to SACC 4001 section 2 as it is written since Poly's maintenance replacement parts are a mix of new and certified like new. Would SSC consider amending Section 02 of 4001 to the following in order for bidders to be compliant: 4001 (2015-04-01), Supplemental General Conditions - Hardware Purchase, Lease and Maintenance. These Supplemental General Conditions are amended as follows: A. At Section 02 of Supplemental General Conditions 4001, subsection 2 is deleted in its entirety. B. At Section 02 of Supplemental General Conditions 4001, subsection 2 is changed to -new quality and must be the same brand and equivalent in function to original equipment parts. C. At Section 25 of Supplemental General Conditions 4001, subsections 3, 5 and 7 are deleted in their entirety. D. At Section 26 of Supplemental General Conditions 4001, subsections 3(a), 3(b), 3(c), 3(d), 3(e) and 3(f) are deleted in their entirety.					
A4	SSC will not amend the Supplemental General Conditions 4001. SSC requires like new parts.
