

## Notice of Proposed Procurement (NPP)

1. This NPP is issued pursuant to PWGSC Supply Arrangement (SA) # E60PQ-140003/C and covers a requirement from the following Product Category(ies) of the SA:

- Product Category 3 - Metal Filing and Storage Cabinets;
- Product Category 6 – Support Space – Collaborative Furniture
- This requirement also contains products that are NON-SUPPLY ARRANGEMENT.

2. *Employment and Social Development Canada, Real Property and Asset Management Quebec* has a requirement for the purchase, delivery and installation of office furniture to various cities in the *Quebec Region*:

*-Laval (Delivery and installation dates: 2023-12-15 and 2024-04-05)*

*-Longueuil (Delivery and installation date: 2023-06-15)*

*-Thetford Mines (Delivery and installation date: 2023-08-31)*

*-Pointe-Claire (Delivery and installation date: 2023-06-26)*

*-Saint-Anne-des-Monts (Delivery and installation date: 2023-06-05)*

*-Montreal (Delivery and installation date: 2023-04-28 or as soon as possible)*

3. This NPP covers a requirement to be solicited amongst the General Stream of Suppliers (SA holders).

4. This requirement is subject to the Canadian Free Trade Agreement (CFTA), the Canada-Columbia Free Trade Agreement, the Canada-Korea Free Trade Agreement, the Canada-Chili Free Trade Agreement, Canada-Panama Free Trade Agreement, Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP), Canada-European Union Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA), Canada-Honduras Free Trade Agreement, the Canada-Peru Free Trade Agreement, Canada-Ukraine Free Trade Agreement and the World Trade Organization-Agreement on Government Procurement (WTO-AGP).

5. There is a security requirement associated with the requirement. For additional information, consult the bid solicitation document.

1. The Contractor must, at all times during the performance of the Contract, hold a valid Designated Organization Screening (DOS), issued by the Contract Security Program (CSP), Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC).
2. The Contractor personnel requiring access to sensitive site(s) must EACH hold a valid RELIABILITY STATUS, granted or approved by the CSP, PWGSC.
3. Subcontracts which contain security requirements are NOT to be awarded without the prior written permission of the CSP, PWGSC.
4. The Contractor must comply with the provisions of the:
  - a) Security Requirements Check List and security guide (if applicable), attached at Annex B;
  - b) *Contract Security Manual* (Latest Edition).
