

AMENDMENT 003

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this amendment is to answer questions from potential bidder:

Q)11.10 Invoicing Instructions

Point 2 – We need a way to be able to invoice each R&O item as it is completed and shipped. Is it possible to revise the agreed-to completion date when an item has been finished early, allowing us to invoice once completed and shipped?

A) They can use the PM-007 Changes order process to request a change to the return date.

Q) Attachment 1B to Part 4 – POINT RATED TECHNICAL CRITERIA

RT-2 – Is the evaluation limited specifically to Repair & Overhaul / Service-type contracts, or is this evaluation open to management of any contract?

A) In Para d) it indicates “A summary of how the services provided for the item listed above align with the core services that constitute repair and/or overhaul.” My interpretation of this is that it does not have to be for R&O related and if it is not, we were looking for a how a non R&O related contract is similar.

Q) Attachment 1C to Part 4 – FINANCIAL EVALUATION PLAN

Reference Annex A 5.0 Materiel Support – Understanding that it is a requirement of the contract for the Contractor to hold DND-owned inventory on-site, we request a category in the pricing schedule for a monthly Storage Fee for the designated locked storage space located in our facility which would be used exclusively to house this inventory and items awaiting R&O. Alternatively, we could include this fee as part of our monthly Management Support Services fee.

A) As indicated in their question; this was meant to be in the Management Support Services fee.

Q) Annex D 1.5.1.4 PI 1

For 626 Taskings that typically span a large period of time and carry significant costs, can we progress bill time and materials on a monthly basis for work completed in that month for each Tasking? It is not ideal for small companies to carry large costs over multiple months.

A) This option is available when requested and accepted by DND in the CDRL PM-006 DND 626 Tasking Estimate.
