The purpose of amendment 001 is to answer questions received, address administrative issues within the Request for Proposal and to extend the solicitation closing date.

## 1. Questions

Question No	Question	Response
001	Can you confirm that Industrial Technological Benefits and Value Proposition does not apply to this Request for Proposal?	The Industrial Technological Benefits and Value Proposition policy does not apply to this Request for Proposal.
002	Does Canada have a schedule preference or the latest deliveries accepted after the initial delivery within 182 calendar days of Contract Award.	After the initial delivery, the remaining equipment must be delivered within 365 calendar days of Contract Award. Please refer to M1 in Annex E, Appendices 1, 2 and 3.
003	Why is the project team seeking both an Interim Spares List and a Recommended Spare parts list at the same time (within 30 days of contract award)? Would Canada accept the recommended spare parts list with pricing upon delivery and then pricing to maintain the fleet for the 24 month requested period?	Both the Interim spare parts list and recommended spare parts list are required for different end users within Department of National Defence to complete certain tasks. Both remain mandatory deliveries in the contract(s).
004	The Standard Instructions 2003 in the Request for Proposal are dated 2022-03-29, should this be 2023-06-08?	The Standard Instructions 2023-06-08 are what applies to this Request for Proposal, please see point 2 below.
005	Can you please confirm that when asking to send offers to Canada Post Corporation's (CPC) Connect service this is the same as Canada Post Epost service?	Canada Post replaced the ePost Connect service with Canada Post Corporation's (CPC) Connect service. Instructions on how to submit bids are located within the Request for Proposal.
006	Can you please confirm that IP65 (or above) is required for the DDS inside his transport case?	Yes, the DDS must have an ingress protection of IP65 or higher without its transport case.
007	Does Canada want to jam and detect ALL bands in between 100Mhz to 6 GHz or Canada wants capabilities to jam and detect SOME RF bands in the 100Mhz to 6 GHz range? That said if it's not ALL bands, how many bands in between 100Mhz to 6 GHz Canada and CAF would like to jam/detect in that 100Mhz to 6 GHz range?	Canada wants the ability to detect and jam ALL frequencies in the bands between 100Mhz and 6 GHz.
008	The ANNEX "I" – SECURITY REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST is empty, is that means there are no security requirements?	There will be Security Requirements associated with the contract(s), the SRCL (Annex I) will be populated at Contract Award.
009	At Annex C, Canada requests pricing for optional quantities of goods. How long is the requested validity for the pricing on these options?	The optional pricing must be valid for the entire term of the Contract.
010	At Annex D, Canada requests pricing for FSR hourly rates for Initial Firm Period 1-5 and for Option Period 1-8. What are the Initial Firm Periods 1-5 and Option Periods 1-8?	Initial firm periods 1 - 5 are the first 5 years of the contract and the option periods are the years following the initial 5 years.

For example, does the evaluated price include pricing for optional quantities of goods or the prices for In Service Support at Annex D?	Clarification provided at section 2 below.
012	With reference to section 4.2.1 Basis of Selection - Lowest Price Per Point, and Annex E, given that the Dismounted Directional System (DDS) has no rated requirements, will Canada evaluate bids for the DDS requirement based on SACC A0031T- Basis of Selection - Mandatory Technical Criteria?	Yes, the Dismounted Directional System will be evaluated on the Mandatory Technical requirements only and the basis of selection will be the lowest cost compliant bid. Clarification is at section 2 below.

## **4.2 Basis of Selection**

### **4.2.1 Basis of Selection - Lowest Price Per Point**

To be declared responsive, a bid must:

- a) comply with all the requirements of the bid solicitation; and
- b) meet all mandatory technical evaluation criteria.

Bids not meeting (a) or (b) will be declared non-responsive. Neither the responsive bid that receives the highest number of points nor the one that proposed the lowest price will necessarily be accepted.

For items in Group A: All lines listed in Annex "C", Appendix 1 – Basis of Payment – Dismounted Directional System, the responsive bid with the lowest evaluated price will be recommended for award of a contract.

For items in Groups B: All lines listed in Annex "C", Appendix 2 – Basis of Payment – Dismounted Omni-Directional System and Group C: All lines listed in Annex "C", Appendix 3 – Basis of Payment – Fixed Site System, the responsive bid with the lowest evaluated price per point will be recommended for award of a contract.

The evaluated price will consist of the total price of all firm quantities in Annex C – Basis of Payment – Acquisition as well as quantity 1 of each Optional Equipment in Annex C.
