Solicitation Amendment # 10

This amendment is hereby raised :

- 1. To include Questions and the Responses for the solicitation.**
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1. Questions and the Responses for the solicitation.

Q#1: 17.1.C.3.1 Will it be possible to obtain a response to a request for approval of an equivalent crane model before submitting the bid?

A#1 : Contractor must reach out to Class to ensure any proposed equivalent is acceptable prior to bid submission.

Q#2 (Question # 5 AMD 009): Some quotes expire after 30 days and it will be hard to know the exact cost until ordering. There will be market changes and variations in exchange rate. How will this be handled?

A#2: Contractor must provide a valid price at the time of bid closing. Prices will be adjusted if a documented price escalates after contract award and prior to the Contractor issuing a Purchase Order.

Currency escalation or decreases will be addressed using the currency rates at bid closing and the rate at issue of the Purchase Order. No changes will be made for variations less than 2%.

Q#3 (Question # 11 AMD 009): There are other good integrators outside Canada. Would there be an opposition to using them over a Canadian integrator?

A#3: No

Q#4 (Question # 21 AMD 009): In Annex D, there are two cases requiring 10M insurance. Does this extend to our Suppliers, FSRs, etc.?

A#4: Contractors may at their discretion flow the terms and conditions down to their Sub-contractors. The prime contractor remains responsible to ensure Canada receives the \$10M coverage on all work.

Q#5 (Question # 22 AMD 009): Is a one-year warranty applicable for all subs, material suppliers, FSRs?

A#5: The Contractor must flow down to Canada any warranty provided by the sub-contractors.

Q#6 (Question # 24 AMD 009): The cost of financial security is Shipyard, but if the cost of security is passed to us in the quotations, do we add this cost to the Shipyard cost in the same box?

A#6: Yes

Q#7 (Question # 27 AMD 009): SOW Item 17.1 With respect to shipping the crane back to Prescott, ON, will Canada consider providing a higher allowance for crane, rigging, loading and freight? Does the allowance for freight include insurance?

A#7 : No Canada will not consider providing higher allowance. The allowance will be for the shipping only and will be adjusted up or down to reflect the documented cost of the shipping. The allowance must cover insurance.

Q#8 (Question # 37 AMD 009): SOW items 16.15 – 16.18 The warranty period for the new flooring is 90 days and it will likely expire prior to vessel trials and custody. What are you anticipating? Should we look into extended warranty.
