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### **1. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:**

#### **Question 1**

Is there a minimum visible height that must remain above water in the Damaged Condition as a visible warning to mariners of a hazard?

#### **Response to Question 1**

No, there is no minimum visible height that must remain above water in the damaged condition as a visible warning to mariners of a hazard as stated in TSOR, the damaged condition constitutes any condition wherein the buoy no longer functions as an aid to navigation.

#### **Question 2**

#### **The following questions are in response to Solicitation Amendment 003**

In the damaged state, a significantly submerged buoy becomes a significant hazard to boaters and could cause serious injury or death, as the buoy is deployed by Canada, are manufacturers supplying buoys to Canada under Canada's specification insulated from legal liability?

#### **Response to Question 2**

As per General Conditions 2010A, the Contractor's responsibility is to deliver goods that meet all the technical requirements and that are free of defects or failures. It is Canada's responsibility to inspect the goods before accepting them. If for some reason they are defective and/or they fail, there is the standard 12 month warranty period during which time the Contractor must remedy the issue.

Is it possible to extend the closing date to 2 weeks.?
