1	Can you clarify the statement “must pass on the first attempt?”	All candidates applying must have taken and passed the exams, or re-certification exams. If they have not yet taken the exams, they must pass on the first attempt. The QAA exam must be passed on the first attempt.
2	Does the proponent need to be Licenced in the particular trade for this to be counted.	No, the experience does not need to be a licensed trade, but details should be given for the type of trade and duties performed.
3	Does experience as an NRCan Certified New Home / ENERGY STAR Advisor count as trade experience?	Experience as a NRCan Certified New Home/ ENERGYSTAR Advisor counts as experience towards “EnerGuide Energy Advisor” (G1) but should not be counted as a trade.
4	Does “Teaching” count as a “Certification”, if the position was granted because of the person’s ability, knowledge of subject matter, years experience in the field?	Teaching a class is not a certification. Obtaining a teacher's degree from a college or University is considered a certification."
