QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 1:

Delivery date for the Launchers is 3 months after contract award. Due to multiples factors that can currently impact the delivery timeline, would you consider permitting a longer lead time?

Answer 1:

90 days is the preferable timeline; however, an extension may be granted following a mutual agreement between the RCMP and the Contractor, and must be due to extenuating circumstances or unforeseen delays.

Question 2:

Are the spares and accessories to be purchased at the time of initial purchase or at some future date?

Answer 2:

Basic maintenance parts will be sourced during initial purchase based on manufacturer recommended spares. Subsequent parts orders will be on an as required basis.

Question 3:

Please see page 44 of 62 in the RFP. There are accessories listed with no reference to quantity or desired delivery time. The solicitation calls out a list of accessories but provides no quantities or timeline for purchase. Would you please provide an indication as to the quantities for each item and when you would plan to purchase the items?

Answer 3:

The requirement for accessories is to assure they are included for subsequent purchase based on the specific needs of the users. Please refer to Solicitation Revisions 3 and 5 of this Solicitation Amendment

Question 4:

You are requesting firm prices for the accessories however you do not specify if the prices are to be firm for the initial one year period or the option years. Would you please clarify?

Answer 4:

Firm pricing for both initial and option years is being requested. Please refer to Solicitation Revision 5 of this Solicitation Amendment

Question 5:



On page 45 there is a table labeled “Optional Parts” This would be a price list of “All available spare parts”. Again, no quantities or delivery timeline has been provided. Further this would not constitute an initial provisioning spares package which would be based on the number of fielded launchers and the spares needed to support them for a period of 1 year. The RFP directs that the spares must be shipped 90 days ARO. Without knowing quantities and planned purchase dates that is very difficult to commit to.

Answer 5:

An initial purchase of spare parts will be based on the manufacturer’s suggested spares which will span the total time period of the RFP. Based on the life expectancy of the launcher spares may be sourced well into the future, thus an initial cost is requested. Please refer to Solicitation Revisions 3 and 5 of this Solicitation Amendment.

Question 6:

While the RFP calls out accessories there is no mention of an initial spare parts package. It will be very difficult to support fielded launchers without having these items on hand. We would recommend that you consider adding a line item to the solicitation requesting an initial provisioning spares package.

Answer 6:

Initial spares will be requested based on manufacturers recommended maintenance parts.

Question 7:

The RFP does not call out a requirement for Special Tools and Gauges (ST&G). These tools are critical to the maintenance and servicing of the launchers. Will you consider adding this requirement to the RFP?

Answer 7:

Yes. Please refer to Solicitation Revisions 2 and 5 of this Solicitation Amendment.
