Description of the Requirement:

The Internal Audit and Enterprise Risk Management Branch (IAERMB) of Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC) requires specific skill and knowledge with respect to IT Security to assess whether appropriate departmental IT security mechanisms are in place and working properly.

Bidders must submit a bid for all resource categories.

Level of Security Requirement:

Security requirement for Canadian supplier: Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC) file # 100022520

1. The Contractor must, at all times during the performance of the Contract, hold a valid Facility Security Clearance at the level of **SECRET**, issued by the Contract Security Program (CSP), Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC).
2. The Contractor personnel requiring access to CLASSIFIED/PROTECTED information, assets or sensitive site(s) must EACH hold a valid personnel security screening at the level of **SECRET or RELIABILITY STATUS, as required**, granted or approved by the CSP, PWGSC.
3. The Contractor MUST NOT remove any CLASSIFIED/PROTECTED information or assets from the identified site(s), and the Contractor must ensure that its personnel are made aware of and comply with this restriction.
4. Subcontracts which contain security requirements are NOT to be awarded without the prior written permission of the CSP, PWGSC.
5. The Contractor must comply with the provisions of the:
 - (a) Security Requirements Check List and security guide (if applicable), attached at Annex C ;
 - (b) *Contract Security Manual* (Latest Edition).

NOTE: There are **multiple levels of personnel security screenings** associated with this file. In this instance, a Security Classification Guide must be added to the SRCL clarifying these screenings. The Security Classification Guide is normally generated by the organization's project authority and/or security authority.

Applicable Trade Agreements:

This procurement is set aside from the international trade agreements under the provision each has for measures with respect to Indigenous peoples or for set-asides for small and minority businesses.

Further to Article 800 of the Canadian Free Trade Agreement (CFTA), CFTA does not apply to this procurement.
